





P&O CRUISES TO SAY A FINAL FAREWELL TO ADONIA

&O CRUISES HAVE confirmed that Adonia will leave the fleet next year, with contracts signed to sell the small ship to Azamara Club Cruises.

The sale of the 30,000-ton ship will complete in March 2018, with the D804 sailing leaving from Barbados on 23 February and ending in Barbados on 9 March 2018 to be her last for P&O Cruises. Azamara Club Cruises will receive delivery of Adonia the same month, renaming the ship 'Azamara Pursuit'. The 704-passenger ship will undergo extensive refurbishment to bring its décor in line with Azamara Journey and Azamara Quest.

Speaking about the sale of Adonia, P&O Cruises senior vice president Paul Ludlow said: "During her time with us, Adonia has captured the hearts of many thousands of P&O Cruises guests. "She has ventured into new ports of call around the globe and has negotiated Icelandic Fjords, European rivers and Caribbean coves. We will ensure that these discovery itineraries are continued on other ships in the fleet.

"With almost six months until Adonia leaves the fleet, we will ensure that each of the cruises in her final season with us are extra special and celebratory."





NEW CUNARD SHIP TO JOIN THE THREE QUEENS

HE ICONIC CUNARD fleet will welcome a new ship in 2022.

The vessel will become the first new Cunard ship in 12 years, joining Queen Mary 2, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth to make it the first time since 1998 that the cruise line has had four ships in simultaneous service.

Sharing the recognisable livery and red funnels, the new ship will accommodate up to 3,000 guests and will merge Cunard signatures with brand new experiences. Simon Palethorpe, senior vice president of Cunard, said: "We have only recently marked the 50th anniversary of one of Cunard's much-loved ocean liners, the legendary QE2.

"What better way to celebrate her important role in Cunard's past than by announcing our commitment to Cunard's future with the commissioning of a new ship. Cunard offers unrivalled luxury ocean experiences and the new ship firmly underpins our plans to continue our growth across international markets."

Further details about the new ship are expected to be revealed over the coming months.

SAGA CRUISES ANNOUNCE SECOND NEW SHIP

Saga Cruises has confirmed plans to extend its fleet of new build ships.

Spirit of Adventure is expected to be delivered in 2020, becoming a sister ship to Spirit of Discovery which sails in July 2019. The 58,250-ton vessel will carry less than 1,000 passengers in all-balcony accommodation.

Lauren Batchelor, chief executive officer of Saga plc, said: "Our first new ship, Spirit of Discovery, will be in service in June 2019 and with pre-sales being very strong, this confidence in demand has supported our decision to expand the new build fleet and purchase our second new ship, to be delivered in August 2020."

VIKING OCEAN TAKES DELIVERY OF FOURTH SHIP

Viking has taken delivery of its fourth ocean ship in a ceremony at the Fincantieri shipyard in Ancona, Italy. Viking Sun will sail consecutive World Cruise itineraries, beginning with Viking's first-ever, departing from Miami on 15 December 2017. Over the course of 141 days, the ship will visit 66 ports in 35 countries, before ending its voyage in London on 5 May 2018. In 2019, Viking Sun will continue to circle the globe, completing a recently-announced second World Cruise, which spans 128-days, five continents, 21 countries and 44 ports, including 10 overnight stays in port.

SILVERSEA ANNOUNCE NEW SHIP FOR 2020

S ILVERSEA HAS ANNOUNCED its order for a new cruise ship for 2020. Silver Moon will be built by Fincantieri and will be a twin sister of the recently launched Silver Muse.

The 596-passenger, 40,700-ton vessel will be almost identical to Silver Muse, with some minor tweaks planned for the original design. One such change

will be the expansion of the popular Atlantide restaurant. The new ship will become the tenth ship in the Silversea fleet and will have a 'Green Star 3 Design', created to prevent air and water pollution.

The cruise line recently announced plans for enhancements across the fleet, including a dramatic makeover of Silver Spirit in dry dock next March. The installation of a new 49ft midsection will increase guest capacity on the Silversea ship, adding 26 Veranda Suites, six Silver Suites and two Panorama Suites. Changes will also be made to dining venues and décor in suites and public areas indoors and out, bringing the ship in line with Silver Muse.





HAIRSPRAY TO HIT THE SEAS


Royal Caribbean has confirmed that Tony Award-winning Broadway musical 'Hairspray' is to headline the main theatre entertainment on board Symphony of the Seas.

The cruise line promised the new show would be 'bigger than ever' on board the fleet's fourth Oasis-class ship, having previously enjoyed a successful run on board Oasis of the Seas until 2014, when it was replaced by 'Cats.'

ROYAL CARIBBEAN REVEAL MORE ON NEW INDEPENDENCE FEATURES

Revealed more information on the new features to be introduced to Independence of the Seas during its April 2018 refurbishment.

In addition to the Escape Room, Trampoline Zone and laser tag arena already announced, the update will also see the ship's existing water park upgraded to become Splashaway Bay, complete with water slides, water cannons, fountains, pools and the drench bucket. Other features resulting from the extensive dry dock are set to include brand-new Panoramic Ocean View cabins with wraparound floor-to-ceiling windows, plus an improved ice rink and the introduction of Izumi Asian restaurant, a favourite elsewhere in the fleet.

EBRIDEAN PRINCESS WAS once earmarked as an oceangoing hideaway for the Scottish government, intended to whisk away the 'very important people' in case of a nuclear war. Fortunately, it was never required to serve such a purpose, instead living a more utilitarian life as a car ferry from 1969. Not very James Bond, but a necessity around these remote parts of western Scotland. Then, more than 20 years ago, it underwent the extensive, extravagant transformation that would turn it into the Hebridean Princess that myself and 45 more guests were to call home for the first week of October.

Hebridean Princess isn't the first cruise ship to be described as a floating country house but this tiny vessel takes the comparison a step further. Whilst there is a distinct lack of sprawling gardens usually associated with such estates, it ticks all the other boxes. My cabin for the week, the Isle of Coll, could certainly be classed as stately. The country pursuit themed upholstery and flickering fire in the Tiree Lounge wouldn't look out of place in a Scottish castle, along with the exposed brickwork, inglenook fireplace and wood beams. If it wasn't for the islands and islets passing by the window, with the odd appearance from dolphins, seals and seabirds, you could quite easily think you were squirrelled away in a stately home in the Scottish Highlands. Only the scenery changes here. Each morning of our 'Flavours of Scotland' itinerary brought a new coastline or island into view, the hours in between filled with ever-changing landscapes as we cruised through lochs and sailed the Sounds. If you have long held hopes of visiting Scotland and its islands, this is the way to do it.

From the moment I embarked Hebridean Princess in the Victorian fishing town of Oban, it was a case of 'so far, so Scottish'. The sound of bagpipes rang out from the Skye Deck as we were welcomed aboard individually, welcome drinks served in the tartan and tweed-clad Tiree Lounge. The decanter of whisky in my cabin was a sign of more to come; from whisky distillery tours to hot toddies after trips ashore and even a wee dram in your morning porridge should you want it, I'm 97% sure the ship runs on the stuff.

If the whisky were to run out, the crew have what it takes to keep things simmering along nicely. From Sven's service with a smile at mealtimes and tour guide Rita's encyclopaedic knowledge of the isles, to Egon's quick wit and 'calorie-free, the more you eat the slimmer you get' biscuits after breakfast and Chief Purser David's nightly stories, tongue in cheek crowd pleasers that made me wonder why we ever replaced late-night storytelling with more raucous entertainment; they are all part and parcel of the Hebridean Princess experience. One wouldn't work without the other, the cosy surroundings of the ship brought to life by the staff of 38 who run it. By the end of the week, they felt like family.





FAMILIAR FACES

Y FELLOW GUEST, Celia, has spent 17 years trying to find fault with the crew and with Hebridean Princess in general. Nineteen cruises later, she's still trying.

"I came on board for the very first time after my husband passed away 17 years ago and I was terrified. I expected to spend my time alone, see some of the islands and just travel a little, but Charles took me under his wing and it felt like coming home," she told me after dinner one evening.

"I keep coming back because I'm trying to find something to complain about. There has to be something."

She hasn't found it yet and I have a sneaky suspicion she comes back simply because she loves it. She's welcomed aboard with the same sort of warmth and respect one expects Her Majesty The Queen received on the two occasions she holidayed on Hebridean Princess. The crew love her. There's no handshake on arrival from Captain Richard Heaton, but a hug instead. Egon is as attentive towards her as you suspect he is with his own grandmother, escorting her ashore in his tartan flat cap and keeping her glass topped up in the Tiree Lounge. Sven, Louise and Valeria in the dining room know it is warm milk with coffee at breakfast, champagne only before dinner and nothing but French wine at mealtimes. Celia is one of their own.

Hebridean Princess is perfect for solo travellers like Celia. It's impossible to lose yourself on the pint-sized ship and the crew are as attentive as any I've ever come across. There's a convivial atmosphere between guests, conversation coming easy in the Tiree Lounge and over dinner in the Columba restaurant, where the singles shared tables of eight. When I embarked, housekeeper Fiona had compared the Hebridean Princess experience to 'a house party' and I couldn't have put it better myself. The cruise line has an incredible return guest record and there was only a handful of us who hadn't holidayed with Hebridean Island Cruises before. It meant that familiar faces shared stories about cruises past, from revelations about



whether they had been a stroller or a walker on the Footloose cruises, to tales of seal safaris in the speedboat and whale watching from the bow. Hebridean Princess keeps them coming back for more.

Our 'Flavours of Scotland' itinerary was as indulgent as its name suggests, fine dining in five-star restaurants on land bookended by breakfasts and dinners on the ship. The Three Chimneys, 1887 at The Torridon and the Isle of Eriska Hotel have all held Michelin stars in their time and they became a marker against which to measure the service and cuisine on Hebridean Princess. While the crockery was simpler and the décor humbler, the ship's Columba Restaurant met the mark in every way. In fact, as we waited an age for wine and water at the Three Chimneys, where reservations must be made months in advance, I couldn't help but think that our glasses had never found themselves empty on the ship.

Our taste test of Scotland's finest flavours saw us enjoy a liquid lunch at the Bruichladdich Distillery on the Isle of Islay and meet the beekeeper behind the honey used at breakfast in the tiny village of Scalasaig on Colonsay. He helps out with the oysters on board too, switching between the two on a rotation governed by the Scottish seasons. We visited the Isle of Mull Cheese Farm for a private tour and plenty of samples, the farm's sweet young calves prompting most to shun the veal option at dinner that night. We chatted over coffee and cake in a yellow chocolate shop in Tobermory, then did more of the same at the magnificent Raasay House. On our last evening, we rounded off a fantastic (and filling!) week

with a champagne reception at Duart Castle, hosted by Sir Lachlan MacLean. Later, as a haggis was paraded around the dining room by kilt-clad Chief Purser David, Captain Heaton following up with a recital of Robert Burns' 'Address to a Haggis' in his very best Scottish accent, I realised that this was just an average Monday night on Hebridean Princess.

Until I had experienced Hebridean Island Cruises, the only thing I had in common with The Queen was a tendency to rarely carry cash. A week later, we shared a love of the same ship. As I made my way to the luxury coach for our scenic return transfer to Glasgow, I realised it wasn't just Egon's 'calorie-free' biscuits I would miss.





HOURS IN BARBADOS

Catching a lime to calypso beats, clad in carnival colours and fuelled by Banks beer; it's the epitome of island life.

DON'T MISS...

CCORDING TO Trip Advisor, the second most popular attraction in Barbados is one which flies under the radar, a hidden gem in every sense of the word. Hunte's Garden is on the island's windswept east coast, just a half hour drive from Bridgetown, but this oasis in the heart of the Barbadian rainforest feels more like the Garden of Eden. Green-fingered horticulturist Anthony Hunte created the tropical garden in a giant sinkhole over the course of two years. Many years later, he still tends to his plants, albeit with a little help from his assistant. After exploring the gardens, join Mr Hunte himself for fresh lemonade on the veranda of his home

overlooking the blooming crater. Whilst you're on the east coast, combine your visit to Hunte's Garden with a stop off at nearby Harrison's Cave or a couple of hours monkeying around with the green monkeys at Welchman Hall Gully.

The island's beautiful west coast is dubbed the 'Platinum Coast' for a reason. Its ultraluxury resorts are interspersed with the multimillion-pound homes of celebrity sunseekers, many of whom head to Limegrove when they're bored of the beach and determined to splash some serious cash. Barbados' ultimate shopping destination is a 20-minute drive from port and you'll find the boutiques of designers such as Gucci, Burberry, Hugo Boss,









Cartier and Breitling waiting to give your credit card a work out. It probably isn't the place for picking up those last few holiday essentials, but if you are feeling flush, this is the place to spend it like Beckham. When you're all shopped out, a courtyard bar and rooftop restaurant serving Asian-fusion food awaits.

Any Caribbean cruise alumni will smile knowingly at the mention of The Boatyard. If your idea of a perfect day in paradise involves white sand, cold drinks and an hour or two spent scoping out the local marine life, this is your spot. The Boatyard is a \$5 taxi ride from the cruise port and access to the Carlisle Beach location will set you back around \$50 or \$25 for children under 6. The attraction is great value for money with your entry fee including a beach chair and umbrella, rope swings and trampolines in the water, clean shower facilities and a voucher for food and drink, plus a free boat ride to snorkel with turtles at a reef just off the coast. There's also free Wi-Fi and a complimentary transfer back to the ship at the end of the day. You can easily spend a whole day here, listening out

for the free shots siren if you came to party or venturing to the top end of the beach where the sands are serene.

Finally, we come to the Oistins Fish Fry. Caribbean connoisseurs know there is no better place to be on a Friday night. The sand beneath your feet, the smell of jerk chicken cooking on the barbecue, the lazy reggae beats and that very first sip of an ice-cold Banks beer are all experiences that await at the most eclectic party in the Caribbean. Local youngsters catch a lime on picnic benches, elders embroil themselves in Domino warfare, licking the pepper sauce from their fingers between turns. Plates are piled high, not just with seafood as the Oistins Fish Fry name suggests, but with sticky barbecue ribs, lamb stew and macaroni pie too. The fish is the main event of course, from red snapper and marlin to dolphin. Don't worry, Flipper is safe for now; dolphin is merely the Bajan name for the mahi-mahi fish. Arrive hungry and aim to be there ahead of opening, in time to enjoy the 6pm sunset with a beer in hand whilst the barbecues are fired up.

TUCK IN...

HE CLIFF IS a Bajan institution and whilst it isn't cheap by any stretch of the imagination, the eye-watering prices are well justified by the experience. With a clifftop position above a secluded cove, the uber romantic torch-lit location is hard to beat if you're looking for somewhere to celebrate a special occasion. Book a table by the railings and you'll be close enough to hear the waves lap the sand and see the fish swimming in the seas below. Reservations are a must.

Lesser known but equally as impressive in culinary terms is The Lone Star, a former 1950s petrol station that retains its retro character as it serves up culsine considered to be some of the best on the island. The Lone Star has become the place to see and be seen, with A-listers heading here for a taste of home during their extended sojourns and legendary restaurant critic, Michael Winner, once describing it as 'The Ivy of the Caribbean'. The restaurant is right on the beach and a rum sour on the boardwalk sets the tone, before you tuck into European fare with added Caribbean flair. We quite like the sound of the Yellowfin tuna tartare, followed by the English classic, roasted rack and braised shoulder of lamb.

For quintessential Bajan cuisine, Brown Sugar is the place to be. Pepperpot stew, flying fish and the island's signature cou-cou is all on the menu at the restaurant's famed Planter's Buffet Lunch, not to mention the coconut cream pie and Bajan bread puddings for dessert. The local favourite is just outside of Bridgetown, making it a great option for satisfying your post-flight hunger pangs before you head over to nearby George Washington House, an 18th century former plantation and one of the island's most popular attractions.

Also within walking distance of Bridgetown Cruise Terminal is the Waterfront Café. This lively spot has a great location overlooking the boatlined Careenage and its Cajun spiced shrimp, jerk chicken wings and flying fish cutter – the Bajan equivalent of a sandwich – are almost as good as the people watching. Live steelpan and jazz music takes things up a notch every Thursday, Friday and Saturday evening.











DRINK UP...

VEN IF YOUVE never heard the term, you're already more familiar with the concept of 'catching a lime' than you might think. When the views are this good, the sun is beating down and you have left all thoughts of schedules and deadlines at home, the only thing left to do is catch a lime at the nearest beach bar.

Legend has it that the piña coladas at Tiki Bar just off the Richard Haynes Boardwalk are the best on the island, a bold claim considering Barbados has over 1000 rum shacks on its sundried soil. Even if the Tiki Bar's famous rum concoction doesn't whet your whistle, one of the other 67 house cocktails on offer will. The sunsets are pretty special here too.

With a motto like 'toes in the sand, rum punch in hand' we knew from the off that Harbour Lights was our kind of place.

The open-air beach club on Carlisle Beach has long been a favourite with cruisers, thanks to its proximity to Bridgetown. The Harbour Lights Beach Extravaganza Dinner Show is unapologetically brash, its live local bands, acrobats, fire eaters and limbo dancers recreating the island's famed carnival yearround. The show starts at 7pm each Monday and Wednesday, with tickets costing \$87.50 including a barbecue dinner, free-flowing drinks, entertainment and transfers to and from your hotel or ship.

If your evening plans involve the Oistins Fish Fry, they should also factor in a visit to the nearby Café Luna. The Mediterranean style restaurant and bar is located at the Little Arches Hotel, just a tenminute walk from Oistins, and its koi carp ponds and botanical plants provide the pictureperfect backdrop for a passionfruit piña colada or two as the sun sets. It's a sophisticated start to a raucous evening at the fish fry.

Finally, you can't come to the home of rum without sampling a tot or two in the place it all began. St Nicholas Abbey and the Mount Gay Rum Factory are the island's two remaining functioning distilleries and both are worthy of a visit.

900g beef shoulder, cut into small chunks

1tsp salt

¹⁄₂tsp pepper

1tbsp flour 1tbsp olive oil 15g unsalted butter 170g pearl onions, peeled 300g red potatoes, cut into chunks 230g button mushrooms, halved 2 large carrots, sliced 950ml beef broth, divided 15g light brown sugar 17g tomato paste 70g beef demi-glace 355ml Oud Bruin beer 5g thyme, chopped 4g flat leaf parsley, chopped

METHOD


Season beef with salt and pepper; dust with flour. In a large, heavy saucepan, heat olive oil over a medium high heat. Sear the beef in batches, transferring to a plate as done; set aside. Add butter to the saucepan, reduce to medium heat and add onions and carrots. Sauté until lightly golden, about 6 minutes. Whisk together a quarter of the beef broth with brown sugar, tomato paste and demi-glace, then add to vegetables. Stir in beer and bring to a boil over high heat. Reduce heat and simmer for 20 minutes. Return beef to the pan, along with the potatoes, mushrooms, thyme and remaining beef broth. Cover and simmer for 11/2-2 hours, or until beef is very tender. Stir in parsley and cider vinegar to taste before serving.
