





RISE IN BRITISH RIVER CRUISERS



The number of Britons taking a river cruise has risen by 21% year-on-year, according to new figures released by CLIA UK & Ireland.

The UK river cruise market reached 210,400 passengers in 2017, compared to 174,400 in 2016 and 129,700 in 2012. The average length of a river cruise has risen from 6.7 days to 7.7 days as cruisers look to embark on longer itineraries. The Nile has seen a notable increase in passenger numbers, growing just over 16% since 2016. Even more noticeable was an upsurge in Britons cruising India's rivers, with 27% more Britons taking a cruise there compared to 2016.



AZAMARA CHRISTENS PURSUIT

ZAMARA CLUB

Godmothers Ellen Asmodeo-Giglio, executive vice president and chief revenue officer of AFAR Media, and Lucy Huxley, editor-in-chief of Travel Weekly, were on hand to send two bottles of champagne smashing against the ship's hull in unison in the traditional good luck blessing.

Azamara Club Cruises announced its purchase of P&O Cruises Adonia in September 2017 and the subsequent rebranding of the ship as Azamara Pursuit. The ship's transformation started with an extensive refurbishment in the Bahamas, including mechanical upgrades and exterior paintwork, before it crossed the Atlantic to Belfast for a dry dock period.



Described as 'hotel upgrades', the renovation saw a team of 650 people transform the interior. Pursuit emerged with 351 cabins and additional suites, with a capacity of 702 passengers; marginally more than sister ships Azamara Journey and Azamara Quest. While it accommodates more guests, Azamara Pursuit retains the same neutral yet sophisticated styling as its fleetmates.

Pursuit will sail to various destinations that are firsts for the Azamara fleet, including South America. In total, the ship will visit 60 destinations unique to the fleet over the coming season.

NIEUW STATENDAM COMPLETES SEA TRIALS

IEUW STATENDAM, THE second ship in Holland America Line's Pinnacle Class, has completed its sea trials.

A routine testing phase in the shipbuilding process, sea trials are designed to test a ship's mechanics and systems on open water before it welcomes passengers. Speaking about the important stage in the run up to the ship's anticipated launch in December this year, Orlando Ashford, president of Holland America Line, said:



"The sea trials are a highly anticipated milestone for any new-build because it takes us one step closer to delivery, and we're thrilled that Nieuw Statendam gave a strong performance out in open water."

He continued: "There's a lot of buzz surrounding Nieuw Statendam and the innovations we're introducing onboard. The ship is going to have an exciting debut in early December."

As sister ship to the Koningsdam, the 2,666-passenger Nieuw Statendam will share many of its signature features including Billboard Onboard and Dinner at the Culinary Arts Center. It will also feature a number of exclusive fleet-first spaces. The ship will cruise the Caribbean from Fort Lauderdale in its inaugural season, before spending summer 2019 in Northern Europe, Iceland and the Mediterranean.



VIKING CRUISES BECOMES **ADULT-ONLY**

Viking Cruises has announced that it will no longer accept guests under the age of 18 on its river cruise ships.

While the cruise line has always focused on adult-targeted versions of river and ocean cruising, the minimum age for its river cruise itineraries formerly stood at 12. Viking Ocean Cruises already limited its sailings to passengers aged 18 years and above.

In the past, Viking chairman Torstein Hagen

has described the cruise line's determination to create a cruise experience specifically with adults in mind.

"We are proud of what we are not," he said at the launch of the fifth Viking Ocean cruise ship, Viking Orian, in June.

"No children under 18, no umbrella drinks, no photographers and so forth. By peeling off all these things, we make it a much more quiet experience."

PRINCESS CRUISES NAMES NEW SHIP

Princess Cruises has revealed its fifth Royal-class ship will be named Enchanted Princess.

Following her scheduled launch in June 2020, Enchanted Princess will become a sister ship to Royal Princess, Regal Princess, Majestic Princess and Sky Princess. She will be followed by a sixth Royal-class ship in 2021. Princess Cruises also has an order for two Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) ships to be delivered in 2023 and 2025, bringing its total new ship order to five ships in six years. The fleet currently operates 17 ships in more than 380 destinations.

Jan Swartz, president of Princess Cruises, said: "The name Enchanted Princess is captivating and conveys the elegance and grace of our new ship which will introduce more travellers to the pleasures and value of cruising. "We are certain Enchanted Princess will exceed the expectations of our guests, ensuring they have the most memorable cruise."

Enchanted Princess will sail European voyages, with itineraries on sale in early November.







HE ALMOST CONSTANT presence of sunshine means that Lisbon feels permanently tinged by the lazy haze of summer, something that is taken full advantage of in each of its vibrant districts. 

BONAIRE

FHOLIDAYS TO you mean the deepest blue, it has to be Bonaire. The tiny picturesque isle some 50 miles off the coast of Venezuela has world-famous waters suggested to be the sole reason for 80% of visits. There's a long list of Caribbean idylls claiming to be 'one of the world's top dive destinations' but when an island embellishes its number plates with proclamations of 'Diver's Paradise', you start to realise just how seriously they take their sea life.

Back on dry land, the shrimp-filled pools of Bonaire's salt flats show off tens of thousands of coral-hued flamingos in all their glory at the Pekelmeer Flamingo Sanctuary. Bonaire is the Caribbean in technicolour. Its seas bluer, its marine life more vivid and its towns even more colourful than your average paint box port of call.



TELLING TALES

PAUL THEROUX

EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW


Paul Theroux is considered the godfather of travel writing, sparking our sense of adventure for decades with classics such as Deep South and Ghost Train to the Eastern Star. His insatiable appetite for travel will see him join some of the world's most respected creatives on 'The Tale of Tales', Silversea's 133-day World Cruise from San Francisco to London in 2019. Ahead of his time at sea, he spoke exclusively to Rebecca Martin for Into The Blue about the romance of cruising, the luxury of time and the belief that there really is no place like home.

HILE FAMOUS FOR his far-flung and often unplanned adventures around the globe, Paul Theroux is no stranger to the luxury of cruising, having recently sailed from Papeete to Auckland. As someone who has long encouraged us to disconnect from technology when travelling, to be in the moment and make new connections as opposed to keeping constant contact with home, how does he find the solitude of time at sea?

"The ideal cruise combines socializing with solitude. I can only read and write when I am uninterrupted – a voyage is ideal for concentrating on reading. On board you always see people with a book. But there are parts of the day when meeting people, dining together, having a drink with a friend is a welcome break. Many great writers wrote books on ships – Mark Twain, Jack London, Somerset Maugham."

As well as the aforementioned literaries, Paul lists explorers such as Captain Scott amongst his greatest inspirations, those who crossed oceans and climbed mountains. Does he think that, to an extent, writers share that same innate sense of adventure and yearning to explore?







"A novel is an inner journey," says Paul, "an uncovering by degrees of what is in your imagination. It's mainly a sedentary occupation – relieved of course when it takes place on a sea voyage. I began life wanting to be a traveller, and have always felt the need to get out of the house when I've finished writing a book. By 'get out of the house' I mean go to Africa, or India, or to a Pacific island. Lately I have been travelling in Mexico. But I nearly always travel with an idea of writing about it. I aspire to be that wide-awake person whom Henry James advised, "Try to be one of those on whom nothing is lost."

Some might say that the World Cruise and time spent at sea still retains an air of romance, much like the train journeys that have inspired some of Theroux's most noted works. Would he agree?

"Yes indeed, because for one thing the experience of cruising does not have any of the anxiety and uncertainty of flying – and this is true also of train travel. You show up, climb aboard and off you go, in comfort. This relaxation improves your mood and adds to your ability to think about the journey, the wider world, and your place in it."

A World Cruise sees life steady to a slower pace, with more focus on immersive experiences ashore and leisurely sea days with a book than on ticking destinations off a list. Could it be that time has become the ultimate luxury?



"Travel at its best is not something hurried, but rather an experience of time as well as space," says Paul. "The world is what it has always been – a theatre of events. In the past we were unaware of most of these events, or got the news late. These days the overload of information is daunting, and so intimidating, that a sea voyage is like a refuge from the worst of it – a refuge in which the passenger gets a better perspective of the world, and can verify events when the ship touches shore."



It would be easy to assume that Theroux has seen more of the world than most but rather than craving a return to familiar shores, he has in the past shared his belief that we can in fact become homesick for the places we haven't yet been. So, where does he hanker after visiting that hasn't yet made it on to one of his itineraries?

"As a writer, needing solitude and a routine, I am happiest when I am home with my wife. No foreign destination – no matter how exotic - can compare with a happy home. Perhaps an odd thing for a committed traveller to say, but it's true. There are many places I hanker to travel to (I have never been to Scandinavia, Bhutan, or the Galapagos), but I should say that one of the most enlightening experiences possible in travel is 'The Return' – after a long time, seeing how a country or a city has changed; because then you have some idea of what is happening to the world, for better or worse."

HAVE FELT THE wind in my hair on a RIB ride through the Norwegian Fjords and I've risked it all on red at the Casino de Monte Carlo. I've visited the Grasse perfumeries, florals in the rolling hills around them solely responsible for the Chanel No. 5 my mum has worn for as long as I can remember. I've toured the gritty underbelly of Rome's Colosseum and I've walked the same red-carpeted steps as Julia Roberts in Cannes, albeit in a Topshop sundress as opposed to a floor-sweeping frock worth thousands. I've hacked through the New Forest on an unruly horse called Nina and I've slipped into a full-length

scarlet number to sip champagne in the family castle of a Scottish laird. So what, I hear you say, quit the bragging. My love for travel has gifted me some amazing experiences for which I will be eternally grateful but the crucial point to note is that I did all of the above alone. Always solo, sometimes when single, other times when not. For work and for play, all the while fuelled by a desire to see the world that doesn't always align with the schedules of friends and family.

I'm no brave adventurer, hell I don't even own a backpack. I like the home comforts of a nice hotel or ship and I'm a firm believer that there's no such thing as arriving at the airport too early, especially if it means starting my holiday with avocado and eggs on toast at a table for one, the first few pages of a holiday read my only company. My trusty navy Converse have walked more miles than I care to admit, though their battered appearance might well give the game away. I always forget to pack a hairdryer, a lack of travel companions serving as my saving grace when the humidity of a summer's day on the French Riviera creates a halo of frizz Monica Gellar would admire. I almost always get lost and I can never quite remember whether I should pay the bill in the local currency



concentration to make sure you're headed to your hotel and not back to the same airport you just came from (based on a true story). It is terrifying and thrilling in equal measure and it leaves you feeling like you could probably take on the world. Or, at least, a little bit of it for somewhere between seven to 14 days.


While it might seem it at times, solo travel isn't as unusual as you might think. According to ABTA, 12% of the UK population holidayed alone last year and 18% of over-65s have travelled alone in the last 12 months. In fact, the average solo traveller is 57; throwing caution to the wind and embarking on an adventure for one is no longer the reserve of the gap year kids. The growing trend for going it alone shows no sign of slowing, with searches for 'solo travel' tripling in the last decade according to Google. More of us than ever are taking to the seas solo too and the cruise lines are taking notice. Around 20% of Saga Cruises passengers travel alone and the cruise line caters for them well, with 100 solo cabins set to feature on their new ship, Spirit of Discovery. Norwegian Cruise Line has offered Studio cabins on all of its most recent ships, grouped together to encourage solo travellers to meet and with a dedicated lounge area in which they can mingle. More single cabins have been integrated into the Cunard and P&O Cruises fleets as part of recent refurbishment works, while Hebridean Island Cruises sets a sizeable 20% of its tiny 50-passenger capacity aside for single travellers.


Of course, the elephant in the rooms of resorts on land and the cabins of ships at sea is the single supplement. While the term still strikes fear into the hearts of solo travellers everywhere, myself included, cruise lines are becoming fairer with their fares. Fred Olsen, AmaWaterways and Hebridean Island Cruises regularly offer selected sailings with no single supplement, while Crystal Cruises charge a single supplement of 50%, rather than the usual double fare. Saga Cruises offer single rooms at no extra cost on selected sailings throughout the year, their chauffer service and dedicated solo travel experts making them one of the most enticing options for anyone planning to take those first tentative steps into holidaying alone.

Once you do make it on board, there is something so liberating about deciding what









you will do with your days, without anyone else to take into account. Wake at the crack of dawn and relocate to the pool without tiptoeing around a sleeping spouse or sleep in and order room service to your cabin, something that feels all the more indulgent after a night of star fishing. Duck out of the evening entertainment to sit and watch the sea from your balcony instead, leaving the curtains open when you go to bed because you want to see tomorrow's port of call come into view and there is nobody to complain that the morning sun streams in too brightly. Dining at the same restaurant three nights in a row doesn't matter when your appetite alone

is the only decider. In fact, the way they get to know your name and that you'll be needing a table for one without even asking tends to be a welcome familiarity boost. When you venture ashore, it's up to you whether you climb that mountain or decide that the only thing getting any exercise today is your credit card.

When you travel alone, you no longer tune out the hubbub around you, as you tend to when you're with friends or family. Instead, those conversations overheard at dinner become your entertainment. Those random interactions give you the head's up on the really hidden gems that wouldn't ever have been on your radar were it not

for a chatty local intrigued by the lone traveller in a sea of couples and families. Travelling solo encourages you to take everything in and with no distractions, it becomes the perfect time to put those niggling worries that have been whirling around in your head to bed. Because what better place to think things through than on a ship in the middle of the ocean, your Wi-Fi sporadic and time all yours to do with what you may.

So, next time you see the woman at a table for one on the harbourside, a glass of Sauvignon Blanc in one hand and a book in the other, rest assured that she isn't lonely. She's having the time of her life, all by herself.

DON'T MISS....

ITTLE RED RIDING Hood, Hansel & Gretel, Sleeping Beauty; there's barely a childhood fairy tale that couldn't have been set in the wooded medieval heathlands of Hampshire's New Forest. The forest thrives, all 145-square-miles of it, surviving almost a thousand years and barely changing an inch. Aside, that is, from a smattering of country pubs, thatched cottages and subtle village shops that have sprung up since the region's past life as a royal hunting reserve.

There is so much to do in the New Forest that it warrants a holiday of its own, but you can cover some serious ground in just a few hours if you go by two wheels or four hooves. You'll have no space for bicycles alongside your holiday luggage, so it's just as well that there are plenty of cycle hire shops around to save you the hassle, including in Beaulieu, Brockenhurst and Burley. More than a hundred miles of off-road routes snake across the woodlands, crossing stone bridges and through chocolate box villages where afternoon tea is a foregone conclusion.

In a place where thousands of wild horses roam free as they did centuries ago, there is something magical about cantering among them. Just outside Ringwood, the Bagnum Equestrian Centre will have you in the saddle and trotting through the woodland on horseback before you can say 'Red Rum'. Available for either one or two hours, hacks are led by experienced instructors and are suitable for anyone over 7 years old and under 15 stone in weight.

If you're cruising with multiple generations in tow, as so many of us do these days, the little town of Beaulieu in the south of the New Forest has something for everyone. There's the National Motor Museum for car-mad dads, featuring 250 vehicles and a new 'World of Top Gear' area that is home to a number of cars used in the infamous Top Gear Challenges. There are serene grounds and garden walks for the greenfingered, plus a Secret Army Exhibition that uncovers Beaulieu's mysterious past

as a training camp for more than 3,000 special agents from the Special Operations Executive during World War Two.

Beaulieu means 'beautiful place' in French and the ancient village sure sits pretty next to the Beaulieu River. Stick around for fresh scones at the Montague Arms Hotel, before working off all those clotted cream calories on the two-mile bike ride to Buckler's Hard, an 18th-century shipbuilding village where ships for Nelson's Navy were built. Pay a visit to the Maritime Museum, before embarking on a leisurely boat ride along the river.

The fanfare-sounding arrival of the Southampton Harbour Hotel has seen the city touted as the UK's next big mini-break destination, a claim that isn't as far-fetched as it once would have seemed. There's history in spades here and walking tours will lay it at your feet. The Titanic Trail unfurls the links between the city and the legendary ocean liner; the RMS Titanic set out from the city's White Star dock in Southampton on 10 April 1912 on her illfated maiden voyage. A visit to the SeaCity Museum delves deeper into the stories of those on board and the connection between the city and the sea.

Southampton's spot on the Solent means an abundance of sea-faring adventures are at your fingertips before you've even stepped foot on a cruise ship. Wet 'n' Wild RIB rides with Seadogz promise to 'put the scream into extreme', so come prepared with a healthy heart and a need for speed.

Less heart-stopping endeavours await on the Shieldhall Steam Ship, the largest working steamship of her type in Britain. Alternatively, take the helm on the Stavros S Niarchos, a 200ft brig-rigged tall ship that will scratch the itch of anyone who has ever fancied themselves as a sailor but doesn't want to commit to a long voyage. A full-day sail costs £139pp and no experience or licence is required.

Southampton's Westquay has always been the place to pick up those last-minute holiday essentials, but an exciting new £85 million dining and leisure development has upped its game. Peruse almost 100 stores for the late additions to your holiday wardrobes, before breaking the holiday diet a day or two early at a tasty line-up of restaurants dishing up cuisine from around the world.

TUCK IN

ESTQUAY'S HIVE OF chain restaurants are delicious and convenient but there are tastier spots across Southampton and further afield.

Bacaro's take on Italian 'bacari' is a taste of the Mediterranean in Ocean Village. Start with small plates of Bresaola Carpaccio and New Forest wild mushroom bruschetta, before moving on to Ravioli porcini.

Mango Thai continues the tapas theme, a £26pp sharing menu taking the hard work out of deciding between small plates of traditional Thai street food and signature in-house creations. It's one of the hottest addresses in town during the weekend but Thursday nights are a particular highlight, thanks to Mango Jam sessions that see Southampton's most talented musicians bring soul, jazz, pop and reggae to the stage.

If food is your thing and a great meal always marks the start of your holiday, THE PIG will

satisfy your appetite for fine British food with a gourmet twist. Chef James Golding employs a forager and kitchen gardener to source ingredients within a 25-mile radius of the New Forest restaurant, with all other ingredients grown in the walled garden or the estate's fruit beds. Flip over the menu of dishes influenced by forest and coast to see exactly where the ingredients in your meal came from, down to the nearest half a mile. It's an indulgent way to start any holiday.

CEAN VILLAGE IS a hive of activity on a Sunday evening, glasses clinking in the bars and boats bobbing in the water of a marina that is thriving in the final stage of a highly anticipated £3.5m transformation. Leading the change is the Harbour Hotel, a portside gem that has attracted rave reviews from locals and cruisers alike since its recent arrival.


It doesn't take venturing much further than the reception desk to realise that there is something special about the five-star addition to the Southampton hotel scene. A sleek spiral staircase beckons you inside and upward, as impressive as any you'll find in the atrium of your favourite ship at sea. Check-in is effortless and with just 85 bedrooms and six luxury apartments, it takes mere minutes to find yourself in your humble abode for the evening.

Nautical inspirations run deep at the Harbour Hotel, from its superyachtinspired exterior to the cheeky retro sailor prints that greet you with a wink as you enter the 'HarBAR on 6th' and the larger-than-life lobster poised on the wall of The Jetty, the Harbour Hotel chain's award-winning restaurant. Cool but classic maritime styling makes perfect sense at this spot on the Solent, the navy and white décor of my Marina View Suite radiating some serious yacht club vibes and equipped with an enormous veranda that wouldn't look out of place beyond the doors of the Penthouse Suite on a sixstar ship. Rooms start at £175 and there are four room types available: Standard Double, Deluxe Double, Deluxe Suite and Marine View Suite. Interconnecting rooms make the hotel a great choice for families too and adapted rooms are also offered. In a nod to the hotel's inevitable popularity

with cruisers, a 'Park and Cruise' package combines dinner, bed and breakfast with up to 21 days parking and a private Mercedes transfer to the port courtesy of the cruise concierge come departure day.

Even when oceans beckon, the Harbour Hotel could prove hard to leave behind. Aside from slumber-inducing bedrooms and grey marble bathrooms decked out



Seafood and local, sustainable produce make up the menu at the award-winning restaurant, its dining room dominated by pistachio glass lightshades knotted in rope nets that could have come complete with the catch of the day. Here, service was as faultless as the food; A Tuna Tuna Tuna starter of soy-soaked tuna fillet and a playful avocado ice cream accompaniment delivered a taste of Asia. A 'Pork, Three Ways' Sunday roast was (whisper it) even better than mum's signature Sunday dinner,

prosciutto pizza and buttermilk chicken burgers, but a reservation at The Jetty is a must if you only have the time or appetite for one meal during your time here.

LAVENDER CRÈME BRÛLÉE

With a subtle hint of lavender, France's quintessential dessert is a taste of Provence.

INGREDIENTS:

1 cup whole milk

6 egg yolks

1 ½ cups of caster sugar

1 tsp. lavender

2 cups crème fraîche

2/3 cup raw sugar

METHOD:

Boil the milk. Remove from heat and add lavender. Leave to chill them while incorporating the sugar until the mixture is nearly white. Strain the chilled milk and place in a saucepan on low heat. Add the crème fraîche slowly while whisking. Let this sit for 45 minutes. Rinse the ramekins with cold water and leave wet. Pour the cream mixture into the ramekins and put them into a water bath with water to mid-height. Place in a 350°F/180C oven for 20 minutes. To serve, sprinkle with raw sugar on top of the crèmes and caramelize either using a kitchen torch or grill for five minutes.


