NEW CRUISE TERMINAL

A new cruise terminal will open in the port of Southampton in 2021

In a huge move towards sustainability, the £55m cruise terminal will let suitably-equipped ships plug in to a local power supply while in port, rather than using onboard generators.

Associated British Ports (ABP) said its opening this year would be a "vote of confidence" in the port. The new cruise terminal will be built in partnership with MSC Cruises and Norwegian Cruise Line Holdings Ltd, and will be the port's fifth terminal for cruise passengers.

Alastair Welch, director of ABP Southampton, said: "We're very pleased to announce this major advance in our cruise infrastructure at the port, delivering further access to Southampton for the industry, whilst supporting our commitment to accelerate improvements in local air quality."

Robert Courts MP, Minister for Maritime at the Department for Transport, said: "As we continue to support the cruise sector in its restart and recovery, it's great to see government funding being used to help deliver better services for

passengers. This next-generation facility also showcases to ports around the world how we're pioneering the use of green technology."

No date has been given for the new opening of the new port, though ABP said it would be 'in time for the 2021 cruise season'.

VIKING OCTANTIS BECOMES FIRST VIKING EXPEDITION SHIP

Viking has taken a step closer towards expedition cruising with the launch of Viking Octantis, with the line successfully floating out its first purpose-built expedition vessel.

The 378-guest ship is set to debut in early 2022, following construction at Fincantieri's VARD shipyard in Norway, and will spend its maiden season in Antarctica and North America's Great Lakes region.

Viking Octantis will be followed by Viking Polaris in late 2022, which will offer voyages to the Arctic and Antarctic. The two ships will become the first vessels to make up Viking's new Viking Expedition brand, with plans for several more ships to launch over the coming years.

All Viking expedition vessels will feature a fleet of zodiac rafts for exploring ashore, along with a scientific laboratory; faux firepits; and both indoor and outdoor swimming pools.





ANNE DIAMOND REVEALED AS VIKING VENUS GODMOTHER

Viking has revealed that TV presenter Anne Diamond will become godmother of its newest ship, Viking Venus.

Anne became one of the original morning TV presenters in the 1980s and has more recently fronted Viking.TV, the cruise line's virtual content platform which launched in March last year. She also became an inspirational campaigner for cot death awareness in the 1990s, following the loss of her own son, Sebastian. The campaign saved over 20,000 babies and saw Anne become the only nonmedic ever to be awarded the Medal of the Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health.

930-passenger Viking Venus is undergoing final outfitting at Fincantieri's shipyard in Ancona, Italy. When launched later this year, it will become the seventh ship in the cruise line's rapidly expanding ocean fleet, sailing itineraries across Northern Europe.

"On behalf of the entire Viking family, we are delighted and honoured to have Anne serve as the godmother of Viking Venus," said Karine Hagen, Executive Vice President of Viking.

Anne Diamond said: "I am thrilled and honoured to be entrusted as godmother to Viking Venus and cannot wait until we

can celebrate her inaugural cruise in a safer and happier 2021.

"Back in March 2020, at the start of the global lockdown, when I rang my good friend Karine to ask if there was anything I could do, never did I think it might lead to such a fascinating journey. But exhilarating journeys are what Viking is all about! I am so proud to be part of the growth."


RESPONSIBLE TOURISM

TECH


2020 saw cash become near obsolete as contactless payment limits were increased, but cruising was ahead of the touchless tech curve and revolutionising holidays long before then. Princess Cruises led the change with the introduction of the Ocean Medallion. Debuted in 2017, the 10p piece-sized wearable device was intended to make the passenger experience more streamlined and personalised. From touchless stateroom entry, to locating friends and family around the ship, not to mention ordering food and drinks without leaving your sun lounger, the technology was unlike anything we'd seen at sea before.

Shortly after Princess came MSC Cruises with MSC for Me, a digital innovation three years in the making, with the family-favourite cruise line working alongside the world's leading digital, tech and behavioural science experts on its development. Like Princess's Ocean Medallion,

the wearable tech can access cabins without contact with surfaces, and can also be used to book restaurants and excursions in real-time, as well as keeping parents informed on the whereabouts of little ones at kids club.

As cruise lines implement new technology to guarantee safe sailings over the years ahead, we'll see more touchless technology come to the fore. All operators in the Royal Caribbean Group will return to the seas with a new and improved smartphone app available, almost completely redesigned to encourage effective social distancing. The technology will include Muster 2.0, an electronic muster drill function that will encourage passengers to complete the obligatory safety procedure in their own time rather than encouraging groups to gather. It'll also mean staggered arrivals at the port and more widely available mobile check-in, as well as stateroom automation on Edge-class ships onwards.







INFORNATA

With the arrival of Silver Moon comes the debut of Silversea's innovative Sea And Land Taste Program (S.A.L.T.). Heralding a new dawn for fervent foodies, the gastronomic concept is all about connecting travellers to destinations through the lens of food and drink. This rustic Cassata Infornata recipe takes us to Sicily, its creamy ricotta filling floating like a cloud on a bed of Italian sponge cake and light shortbread.

INGREDIENTS

For the dough:

- > 500g plain flour
- > **100g** sugar
- > 4g baking powder
- > 170g butter
- > 1 egg plus enough milk to equal 100 ml
- > 8g honey
- > 12ml dessert wine
- > **Pinch** of salt
- > Zest of 1/2 lemon

For the sponge cake:

- > **3** eggs
- > **75g** sugar
- > 75g plain flour, sifted
- > 1/stsp lemon zest.

For the ricotta cream:

- > **1.25kg** fresh sheep's milk ricotta, left to strain overnight
- > 350g granulated sugar
- > **50g** chocolate chips or chopped bittersweet chocolate
- > **25g** candied mandarin or orange (optional), chopped.



METHOD

For the dough:

- 1. Mix the flour, sugar, salt, and baking powder in a bowl.
- 2. Work the butter into the flour until mixture is crumbly.
- 3. Make a well in the centre, add the egg, milk, honey and wine then stir. Knead just until dough is soft.
- 4. Wrap dough in plastic and rest in the fridge for at least 30 minutes.

For the sponge cake:

- 1. Preheat the oven to 175°C
- 2. Butter and flour a 6" round cake pan. Put the eggs into a mixer and beat for 10 minutes. Add the sugar and lemon zest and continue to beat until the mixture forms a ribbon.
- 3. Gently fold in the sifted flour, then pour into the pan and bake for 20-25 minutes, until a toothpick inserted into the centre comes out clean. Cool on a cake rack.
- 4. In a bowl, whip the ricotta and sugar together. Fold in the chocolate chips, then refrigerate until needed.

To assemble:

- 1. Butter the 9-inch spring-form pan and dust with breadcrumbs.
- 2. Divide the pastry dough into two pieces, one slightly bigger than the other. Roll out the larger piece of pastry dough between two pieces of lightly floured parchment paper until 1cm thick.

- 3. Peel off one layer of parchment paper, invert the pan over the dough and carefully flip it over. Peel off the second layer of parchment paper and press the dough into the bottom and sides of the pan, smoothing as much as possible.
- 4. Crumble two thirds of the sponge cake evenly onto the bottom of the dough. Spread the ricotta cream on top of the crumbled sponge, then crumble the remaining sponge on top, pressing down lightly.
- 5. Roll out the smaller piece of pastry dough to fit the top of the cake and pinch the edges to seal.
- 6. With a sharp knife, cross the top to allow air to escape. Bake at 175°C for 30 minutes until golden.
- 7. Rest until cooled slightly, then remove from the pan and leave to cool completely.
- 8. Dust with powdered sugar before serving.
