

#### Madeira

adeira seems a logical place to start in our west-to-east sashay across the islands of the Med. Set aside for a moment that it's not in the Mediterranean but the Atlantic, and that strictly speaking it's an archipelago, and we're good to go.

Geographical disputes settled, Madeira is unarguably a mecca for year-round sun seekers. Closer to Africa than Europe, the mercury rarely dips to a level where you'll need to grab a coat - and if that's not what holidays are made for, we don't know what is. Famed for its fortified wine and dense cake, it's Madeira's lesser-known attractions and little quirks that give the so-called Pearl of the Atlantic its glistening appeal.

Sideline everything you'd expect from a Mediterranean island; Madeira is all about black-sand beaches and thick forest. Lovers of the great outdoors will be in their element, and while a slow-paced amble around Funchal Marina is pleasant enough, adventurous kinds can find themselves much better satisfied. Set your sights on Ribeiro Frio, where nature has kindly signposted the way to some of Madeira's most incredible vistas. Simply follow the path of the Levada, carefully carved by streams of water in centuries past, where you'll be guided up to the Balcões viewpoint. Magnificence doesn't quite cover it; the world below is densely green as far as the eye can see, so take a moment to contemplate

just how stunning this island, sorry, archipelago, is from above before tackling the descent back to reality.

Two-footed travel is hardly the reserve of Madeira, we hear you. But we challenge you to find anywhere else on earth that offers transport quite as unique - and some would say exhilarating - as the carros de cestos. Picture this: You're hurtling down Funchal's streets huddled together in a wicker toboggan, putting all your faith in a pair of waxed wooden runners and the skills of your gondoliers. It's a bizarre experience, and one we promise you will look back on fondly one day. This mode of transport has been around since the mid-19th century, and who are we to argue with tradition?



#### Ibiza

nce hailed as the party island of the Mediterranean, Ibiza has shed its glow sticks in favour of an altogether more adult vibe. Yes, there are still pockets of pure party hedonism to be found in Playa d'en Bossa and Ibiza Town, but this is an island that has far much more to offer.

Dalt Vila is the antithesis to clubbers' Ibiza. With a translation that means 'High Town', this part of the island is exactly that; ascending the narrow cobbled streets will challenge even the most sure-footed of flip-flopped holidaymakers, but boy is it worth the trip. At the top you'll be greeted by the majestic Portal de Ses Taules, and what better way to infiltrate the city walls than via a drawbridge, a fitting entrance to the UNESCO World Heritage Site if ever we've seen one. You'd be forgiven for thinking this is the end of your ascent, but bear with us. Standing proud in the middle of Dalt Vila is a cathedral, and from here you'll be blessed with the best views of Ibiza. Pop inside to cool



off if you must, but you're going to want to savour every last moment of your endeavour.

Finding time to eat and drink like a local is essential while you're in Ibiza. Where once there were alcopops consumed by the dozen and cocktails served by the fish bowl, there are now more refined gastronomic experiences waiting to be discovered. Café caleta is one drink you should try

at least once. A little like a souped up mulled wine, it's become one of Ibiza's best-kept secrets - order in advance, as it's only available in a select few restaurants on the island. Indulge in a slice of flaó while you're at it; this perfumed cheesecake tastes infinitely better than it sounds and will put you well on your way to reaching Ibiza's foodie pinnacle.

The White Isle is infinitely worthy of its title - and Las Salinas Beach will show you why. Located in the heart of Ses Salines Natural Park, the sea is glassy and the sands milky white. It's dotted with chiringuitos, informal bars where you can quickly cool down with a chilled cerveza and reflect on just how wonderful life is.

Ibiza, you've changed. But we love you all the more for it.

No trip to Madeira would be complete without at least sampling its wine. Most of us have a bottle languishing at the back of our drinks cabinet, bundled away somewhere between the saké and specialty sherry. There's no judgement here if you'd rather not take yet another bottle home, but it does seem like something of a rite of passage to sup at least a solitary glass while you're in Madeira. Fajã dos Padres is just the place to do it; only accessible by boat or cable car and complete with its own microclimate, you'll get a perfect viewpoint over the glittering Atlantic. Wine optional, but encouraged.

Madeira has been a mainstay of many a Mediterranean cruise itinerary for years and long may it remain that way.





#### Sicily

Sicily has been alluring travellers with its good looks and sultry side glances for decades. A stone's throw from the Italian mainland, it's a destination most school children learn how to place on a map with the rhyme 'the big boot of Italy kicked little Sicily right into the

Mediterranean Sea'. But rest assured there is nothing down-trodden about this not-so-piccola isola. Plans for a bridge to connect Sicily to the mainland have stalled more times than a clapped-out Lambretta, so with one foot firmly on the brake for the time being at least, Sicily remains cut off by the Messina Strait.

One of Sicily's main allures is its climate. Balmy summers make way for more pleasant autumn and spring sojourns.

No cursory glance over Sicily's offering would be complete without a mention of Mount Etna. The novelty of being home to an active volcano aside, Sicily owes a lot to its brooding presence. Lava-

formed rocky outcrops act as shrines to centuries gone by, while the lush, vibrant vineyards are testament to the fact that life always goes on. The slopes of Mount Etna are where Sicilia DOC wine is produced - and for that, we are forever thankful.

Prepare for a gastronomic reawakening from the moment you step ashore. There's nothing finer than a bowl of pasta con le sarde by the sea; who knew that sultanas and sardines were such a great match? Find yours in Cefalù on the north of the island - an ancient fishing port full of character, charm and

that's arguably more restful than some of its neighbours on the Tyrrhenian coast. With the 270-metre rock that dominates the area looking over your shoulder and the low-key buzz of the harbour, we invite you to pull up a chair, pour a glass of that DOC wine and allow yourself to be wined and dined like royalty.

Sicily's la dolce vita is about as lavish as you can get. Cheers to that.

#### Malta


alta may be small, but it is oh-so-beautifully formed. Home to the tiniest capital city in Europe, this island spans just 20 miles by 10 - you won't find a single lake or river here, but not that it matters. The Maltese islands archipelago is brimming with culture and a resident population who are about as friendly as they come.

A handful of decades ago, you would have been hard pushed to find any tourists who had walked on these fossil-studded shores, but Malta has since made a name for itself as the popular kid on the block. The eagle-eyed will notice nods to a bygone era - this island was British for a short time

(well, over 150 years), before reverting back to independence in 1964. It's been through the Mediterranean equivalent of pass-the-parcel, but for those visitors' laps it has landed in, there is no shortage of layers to unwrap.

The capital, Valletta, is pretty much unavoidable on an island of this size, but it's the old walled capital of Mdina that really caught our attention. Standing proud at the top of a large hill, it's known locally as the Silent City, and as you traverse the narrow streets and discreet alleyways, you'll soon realise why. There are no cars in this part of town; only a select few have permission to drive in Mdina, so you can bask in the Norman and Baroque architecture without beeping horns or the fear of obstructing someone's driveway.

Mankind's finest handiwork may help you while away a few hours in Malta, but it's the archipelago's natural beauty that makes it so enticing. And so the Blue Lagoon beckons. Not to be confused with the Blue Grotto which will feature



is reminiscent of Monte Carlo, but Hvar is some 700-plus miles away, where the sun (almost) always shines and the times are always good. While you're unlikely to be losing your shirt in a Croatian casino any time soon, you'd be forgiven for being swept off your feet by this island's chiselled good looks and obvious wealth sweating out of every pore.

Hvar Old Town is the tonic you need after being blown away by such a grand entrance to the island. A quiet retreat away from the hullabaloo of the harbour, the only sound you'll hear in these parts is the quiet padding of your own footsteps. Winding stone streets and whitewashed buildings stand shoulder to shoulder with Venetian architecture that serves as a reminder

of times gone by. You can spend hours here just wandering, and not feeling like a moment of your day has been wasted.

There are debates over just how many days of sunshine a year Hvar achieves, but rest assured, it's a lot. Sun-scorched landscapes lend themselves beautifully

to growing olives and grapes, so it's hardly a surprise that olive oil and wine remain some of Hvar's prime exports. According to a local saying, a fish swims three times in Dalmatia; once in the sea, once in local olive oil as it's being prepared, and finally in white wine as it is relished during the meal. Put this theory to the test by tracking

down the local dish Hvarska Gregada, a moreish stew of fish, potatoes, onions and garlic finished with lashings of locally-made olive oil. Devour every last morsel, it'll be well worth it.

This island never fails to provide an assault on the senses. Jasmine often circles in the sea breeze, as does the unmistakable scent of lavender. Swathes of purple adorn the landscape in early summer, born out of the



cracked, chalky soils where little else thrives. But don't worry, a trip to Hvar in June or July won't evoke memories of your granny's favourite perfume - this lavender is considered some of the best in the world.

Hvar looks, smells and tastes as good as good can be. A match made in holiday heaven if ever we've seen one.

nevertheless recognised as one of the 12
Treasures of Spain, where it's wedged between the likes of La Sagrada Familia and the Alhambra Palace. So, if you're easily swayed by rankings and the like, this is one to tick off your list. It's very much the Marmite of futuristic buildings, but love it or hate it, this modern masterpiece provided the

backdrop to a Doctor Who episode and featured in the George Clooney flick, Tomorrowland.

But what's inside, we hear you ask? The Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias is home to a science museum, opera house and a planetarium - it really is the attraction to end all attractions. The València Aquarium Oceanografic is right next door; finding Nemo might be a little challenging, as the largest aquarium in Europe, there are a humongous 45,000 living creatures from 500 different species under its roof.

If you want to return home with bragging rights to having seen one of the world's most famous artefacts on your travels, this one's for you. The Cathedral of Valencia is an impressive building in itself, a focal point of surrounding plazas that brings together Baroque, Romanesque and Gothic architecture. But what lies between its four walls is what makes it so deserving of a few of your precious tourist minutes. Valencia Cathedral claims to be home to the Holy Grail - yes, that Holy Grail. Admittedly, there are hundreds of these dotted around the globe, but this is the only one officially recognised by the Vatican. Believe what you will, it's well worth a look and the coolness of the cathedral will give you a few minutes' respite from the Valencian heat.

If that doesn't indulge all your foodie fantasies in one fell swoop, then Mercado Central certainly will. Believe us when we say it's a real feast for all the senses; held in the same building since the 13th century, each section of the market is dedicated to different produce. If you can't find a particular Spanish delicacy under this roof, it's safe to say it probably doesn't exist.

Rest your legs at Central Bar, where all the ingredients are sourced from the surrounding market. Play it safe with the sweetness of a Valencian tomato salad, or push the boundaries with a grilled pig's ear complete with mojo picón sauce.





or a city that's unarguably the Citrus Capital of Europe, you'd be hard pushed not to find a decent tipple. And while a refreshing glass of Valencian orange juice probably can't be beaten, it also forms the basis of another regional speciality: Agua de Valencia.

This local cocktail is a bit like a turbocharged buck's fizz; fresh orange and cava, topped with vodka and gin. Yes, you read that right, a holy trinity of boozy delights go into this concoction. For one of the most authentic Agua de

Valencia, head to Ciutat Vella where there's a huddle of restaurants and bars just waiting to make you one. You might end up needing that siesta,

after all.

Prefer something a little more subdued and less alcoholic? Find time for a horchata. This milky concoction is made from locally-grown chufa nuts

combined with sugar and water; at best it has health benefits (or so locals believe) and at worst it's a delicious drink. Make sure you grab a farton to dip in the cool, sweet, creamy nectar these elongated, doughnut-like pastries are the perfect pairing.

Not only are there plenty of places to try horchata in Valencia, but they're helpfully named 'horchatería'. Depending on how committed you are to hunting down the best in town, you could head slightly north of the city to Alboraya, where the chufa nuts are grown. Alternatively, Horchatería Daniel is nestled right in the city centre and will satisfy your craving just as well.





Seabourn transport their guests to the Inuit town of Pond Inlet, where just 1,600 people call home. It's a far cry from the usual tourist trails of northern Canada, but one that will stay with you forever. Yes, the fjords, glaciers and icebergs are sights to behold, their icy-cold exterior a stark contrast to the warm, welcoming nature of the Inuit people. They'll guide their visitors through the town they are so proud of, speckled with animal hides drying in the watery sun, and wooden sledges providing the preferred mode of transport. It's a world away from normality, but this is what expedition cruising does best.





ou're responsible for the development and operation of Seabourn's global expedition programming - what would you say are the essential components for creating a great expedition?

A great expedition is a combination of remote destinations, where culture and natural history combine to create an educational experience, one that is enhanced by the expedition team who

deliver the product, both on and off the ship. The ship and its capabilities also play a key role, not only by getting you there safely and in comfort, but the overall experience once at the destination. The expedition team, their background and skills are key in the final delivery of the destination experience. At Seabourn, we have

built a ship, designed itineraries, and staffed world-class expedition team members to deliver great expeditions.

**Expedition cruising has been** identified as a major travel trend in 2022 and for years to come. Which itinerary would you recommend to someone who hasn't embarked on an expedition cruise before, and why?

This really depends on an individual's personal interest. Some expeditions

focus on culture, like the South Pacific and Papua New Guinea, others focus on natural history and some voyages are more historical journeys of exploration, like the Northwest and Northeast Passage or a Cape to Cape voyage. The Arctic and Antarctica are incredible destinations with a great combination of natural history and breathtaking scenery. All of these would be excellent first-time expeditions.

> My one recommendation is not to visit Antarctica first. When I used to work as Expedition Leader, I would always start an Antarctica Expedition by saying, "every other destination after this will be dull in comparison". Guests would laugh, but by the end of the expedition, they understood what I meant!

What sort of holidaymaker do you think is attracted to an expedition cruise, and do you think attitudes towards this sort of travel have changed since the onset of the pandemic?


Generally speaking, our guests are

attitudes have changed since the onset of the pandemic. We used to take the ability to fly and travel for granted, now we realise we need to make the most of the time we are given and some of the more bucket list destinations we would put off till later, we want to explore now.

**Expedition ships are kitted out with** a host of features that make them to expeditions?

The ship is equipped with 24 Zodiacs and eight double sea kayaks to explore remote areas. All





Seabourn Venture and her sister ship, Seabourn Pursuit, are built and designed by a team that has extensive expedition operational

experience. We built a ship with excellent autonomy to allow it to explore remote destinations for extended periods of time. It has a PC6 icestrengthened hull, Azipod propulsion and three bow thrusters, allowing it to operate in heavy ice conditions with absolute ease, comfort, and safety. It has a very shallow draft, with a full dynamic positioning system, which gives us access to more secluded, environmentally-sensitive destinations without having to drop anchor.

Seabourn's Sub

We have a world-class 26-person expedition team, comprising scholars, historians, geologists, marine biologists, naturalists, submarine pilots, kayak guides and professional photographers and videographers. We have two six-seater submarines which can take guests to 300 metres or 1,000 feet below sea level, delivering exceptional underwater experiences. The ship is equipped with 24 Zodiacs and eight double sea kayaks to explore remote areas. All of this is complemented by the ultra-luxury onboard experience that is Seabourn. In short, Seabourn Expeditions is a product that has no

compromise between the on and off ship experience. It is a true ultra-luxury expedition.

You mentioned Seabourn's submarines. Can you tell us more about these and what guests can expect from this experience?

The submarines are truly incredible. I have been fortunate enough to do multiple dives in our first two subs, 71/1 and 71/2, aptly named as 71% of the earth is covered by the ocean. Both subs are capable of taking six guests to a maximum depth of 300 metres. The submarines are going to deliver a true expedition experience and I say that because at depths below 40 metres (below scuba diving depths) the ocean is almost completely unexplored.

An average sub dive will be about 45 minutes in duration, exploring depths between 50 to 150 metres. The submarines have eight sets of floodlights and eight sets of LED spotlights giving incredible light at greater depths. Both submarines are equipped with a 4K underwater video camera system, capable of capturing underwater footage, that can be shared later with guests onboard. The submarines are luxuriously appointed with leather seating, air conditioning and a surround sound system.

What guests will encounter while on a sub dive is very region-specific. Some dives may explore a wreck, others coral reefs, some dives might focus on a specific geological formation, others could be exploring the walls of a fjord. What's most exciting for me is the true exploratory nature that the submarines bring to the overall expedition experience.

Where is your favourite expedition destination, and is there anywhere you haven't managed to travel to yet that's still on your bucket list?

For cold-weather destinations, my favourite is Antarctica, coupled with South Georgia. For a warm-weather destination. I would love to return to Aldabra in the Seychelles. New Zealand is a place I have not managed to visit yet and it has eluded me. I would love to visit one day.

What has guests' experience of cruising been like since the onset of the pandemic? Have their attitudes towards holidays changed at all?

Guests' experience of both their ships and cruise as a whole is everything that it used to be, and we're still doing all those magical things we used to do. In the short term, people will notice all the protocols we have in place, but it doesn't get in the way of them having a really good experience. I've been on a couple of our ships and felt very safe; cruising is coming back as one of the safest forms of travel. All the cruise lines have seen record levels of customer satisfaction in the last six months. The crew are happy

to be back, the guests are happy to be back and that really shows.

We're finding that guests more than ever like the security of knowing that every single aspect of their holiday is taken care of from start to finish, and they're working out the value of everything they receive when they book a cruise. This is why we offer an all-inclusive experience, or the doorto-door service as we call it. This starts with an executive limo pick-up service from home, as well as the flight, hotel and transfer. It's all included, as is absolutely everything on board from the fine wines to the fine dining, and all the shore excursions in every port.

The experience doesn't stop when guests disembark, as they'll also be transported back home in an executive limo. Guests now want this extra level of security and assurance.

Do you think guests are becoming more adventurous in their choice of holiday destinations?

Many British guests will sail with us two or three times a year and they like to go back to their favourite places - like for example the Mediterranean or the Caribbean, before committing to something a bit more intrepid, be it an expedition voyage or perhaps venture to a

the world, which means we can accommodate guests who want to travel to the big hitters, but also the far-flung corners of the world.

What we've seen over the past year, despite the environment, is that over 50% of our bookings have been from people booking with Silversea for the first time. I think

those are the people who have done lots of cruising to the usual destinations and now want something further afield. Because we offer that incredible destination experience, and because we operate smaller ships, if you're going to go somewhere like Asia, you will be able to get into some of the most incredible places that bigger ships won't go.

Do you think that expedition cruising is an extension of people's desire to travel to more unusual destinations?

Bucket list travel has always been a big

thing. As people have been cooped up for the past couple of years, the demand and interest in getting some of these bucket lists done is bigger than ever. People are yearning to escape reality and explore the incredible world we all live in. There's a bit of a 'get away from it all' theme going on and expeditions are a

growing interest because they're just a wonderful experience of really getting into the heart of a destination through its wildlife, nature and so much more.

There are three iconic expedition destinations: Antarctica, the Arctic and Galapagos. This summer is a great opportunity to try the Arctic. We have two ships, the Silver Cloud and the Silver Wind, cruising the Arctic and Greenland throughout the summer, which we're expecting to be really popular, especially as you only need to take a three or fourhour flight to join them.

Galapagos is a year-round expedition destination and one that really appeals to families. The real magic of the Galapagos is the wildlife and it is truly a trip of a lifetime. Imagine a family with children or youngsters in their early teens - the experience of being with that wildlife as a family would just be unforgettable.







And for the real explorers, you can't beat Antarctica. It's just an extremely emotional experience. We say it's the closest thing to being on another planet while still being on this one!

We have the most incredible expedition crews on the ship, so not only do you

have the destination itself, but you're also surrounded by a team of 20 on each ship who do lectures, accompany guests and teach them about everything from photography to the environment. It's just a really wonderful all-round experience.

Silversea have been doing this for 15 years and not

only are our expeditions great, but you also get all the luxuries you'd expect from us. When you've been out on your Zodiac circling icebergs and you come back on the ship, it's still the butler who welcomes you back to your suite, there's still chilled champagne if you would like. It's a unique, ultra luxury experience that goes hand in hand with the expedition.

Silver Nova will be the latest ship to join the fleet when she launches in summer 2023 and boasts a number of firsts for Silversea. How important is it for you to continue to innovate and offer guests something they haven't seen before?

We're calling *Silver Nova* the game changer in ultra-luxury cruising. We haven't released all the details and designs yet, but it's a very radically different ship. There's a lot more use of space and of glass - it will be breathtaking when we give out the details. *Silver Nova* will still have everything you'd expect from us in terms of our S.A.L.T programme, Otium Spa, all of our wonderful restaurants, but the design of the ship will just be so different.

We now have the backing of the Royal Caribbean Group which is famous for ship innovation. We've been part of the Group for the past three years and this is the first ship that we have designed and built together - we're combining the

innovation of the Royal Caribbean Group with the luxury of Silversea.

The other big story for *Silver Nova* is the environment. We recognise it's becoming increasingly important for all of us to show how responsible we are going forward on not only

protecting the marine environment, but the environment as a whole. Silver Nova will be the first ship to run on her fuel cell batteries when she comes into port, so there will be absolutely no emissions when she's docked. We also have a mix of different fuels so we can burn the most environmentally-efficient fuels and we're

excited by that. She's a game changer.

Silversea offers hundreds of itineraries covering all seven continents, which would you say is your favourite and why?

The destination I dream of is Antarctica - which I haven't managed to visit yet - but my favourite is the Greek Islands. Now this might not sound terribly ambitious, but the smaller ships mean we can

visit the more unspoilt islands of the Mediterranean. You can go ashore and find a relaxing time, which when matched with the spacious, luxurious ships, just makes for the most incredibly relaxing holiday. The Eastern Mediterranean lends itself to a smaller ship and is proving to be our most popular destination for this summer, not least because it's easy to get to and is close to home.

I think our newer ships, Silver Muse, Silver Moon and Silver Dawn are ideally

suited to first-time cruisers. They each have around 600 guests, and although they're smaller, there are still 10 different dining options on board, as well as a really good-sized spa and gym.

Can you tell us more about the S.A.L.T experience that's available on board?

S.A.L.T - Sea And Land Taste - is proving to be hugely successful on *Silver Moon*, and we're excited to introduce the concept to *Silver Nova* when she launches.

Wherever a ship is in the world, through S.A.L.T we try to give people a taste of that destination. The first thing we have on board is our S.A.L.T Kitchen, which is one of our main restaurants. We'd have a whole beautiful selection of local food and wines, so guests can experience all the food from the region in which the ship is sailing.

The second aspect is the S.A.L.T Bar, a cocktail bar where we recreate all the cool cocktails and drinks from the part of the world we're in. Then we have the S.A.L.T Lab, which is a bit like being on Masterchef. There's a beautiful little room where there are 12 cooking stations, and our chefs will teach people how to cook a local delicacy. When I was on the *Silver Moon* in Greece, we were all taught how to cook moussaka.

Lastly, we have the S.A.L.T Excursions where we take people ashore. We immerse them in the local food culture; for example, we'll take guests to a farm where we show them how local produce is grown, and the farmer will get them to taste some of that food. We then go to a local restaurant where again the chefs there will prepare a beautiful meal, which they will eat on the beach under the trees with the locals. It's all about immersing people in their destination - it has a real wow factor and is proving really popular.

What in your mind is it about Silversea that encourages your guests to return time and time again?



The most incredible thing is our crew. We have the most amazing people welcoming guests onboard our ships and they are the ones who deliver the magic of Silversea. There's a great reunion when guests come back to the ships again and again, they meet up not only with other guests but also the crew.

We're a European business that was originally started by an Italian family, so there's a very cosmopolitan feel onboard our ships. They're not American or British, so we attract people who love to meet the other guests, where they can chat and talk about life. There's people from the UK, North America, Australia and Europe who find the experience very relaxing with lots of great conversation. Each pavilion will explore one of the sub-themes of the expo: Greening the City, Feeding the City, Healthying the City and Energising the City.

loriade 2022 is also home to a living, breathing plant and tree encyclopaedia. Each species growing in the arboretum is alphabetically organised based on their botanical name, so if you already know your agapanthus from your zantedeschia - or could do with a bit of a refresher course - the Arboretum is definitely one to visit.



# THE GREEN HOUSE

There are greenhouses, then there are Floriade greenhouses. Never one to do things by halves, the expo's offering spans a mere 10,000 square metres, and is home to more crops than you could ever imagine. Sustainable cultivation is the order of the day here, so whether

you fancy yourself as a bit of a science buff, or simply like to know how things work, The Green House is just the place to indulge your curiosity. And the good news if you're an avid foodie like us? You can sample what has been produced in the greenhouse at the Kasrestaurant.



# ARTS, CULTURE AND EVERYTHING IN BETWEEN

Plants are undoubtedly the star of the show here, but you will also encounter pockets of arts and culture as you meander your way across the park. Theatre performances, art, cinema and live music are woven into the fabric of the expo, providing plenty of opportunities to sit back, enjoy, and take the weight off your legs for a moment or two. Also find time to drop by The Kunstpaviljoen Flevoland (that's

the art pavilion to you and I), where architecture, art and nature combine.





### SICILIAN PISTACHIO PESTO PASTA

Sometimes simplicity wins when it comes to creating the perfect dish. If you're looking for an extra-special midweek dinner, this delectable Italian delight from Regent Seven Seas Cruises will hit the spot every time.

### **INGREDIENTS**

#### **Serves 4**

#### For the prawns:

- > **450g** large prawns, shelled and deveined
- > 3 tablespoons olive oil
- > 1 tablespoon minced garlic
- > Pinch of pepperoncini flakes
- > 4 slices of lemon, cut in half

### For the pesto:

- > A generous handful of basil leaves
- > 30g shelled pistachios
- > 30g pine nuts
- > 2 garlic cloves
- > **120ml 240ml** extra virgin olive oil, preferably Sicilian

### For the pasta:

- > 450g dried spaghetti or fettuccine
- > 2 tablespoons olive oil
- > 1 shallot, minced
- > **Pinch** of pepperoncini flakes
- > **120ml** white wine, preferably Sicilian
- > 150g cherry tomatoes, halved

#### **METHOD**

- > Preheat the oven to 190°C.
- In a medium bowl, combine the prawns with the olive oil, garlic and pepperoncini and toss to coat. Place in a single layer in a baking dish and intersperse the lemon alongside the prawns.
- > Bake until the prawns are pink and opaque, which will take about five to eight minutes.
- > Remove from the oven and reserve.
- > To make the pesto, add the basil to a food processor, reserving four leaves for garnish. Pulse the remaining leaves, pistachios, pine nuts and garlic. Gradually add the oil and blend, using only enough oil to create a thick paste.
- > Transfer the pesto to a small bowl and cover with cling film and press the

- plastic onto the surface of the pesto to prevent browning. Set aside.
- > Bring a large pot of generously-salted water to a vigorous boil. Add the pasta and cook until al dente. Using tongs, transfer the pasta to a medium bowl. Do not rinse or add any oil. Reserve the pasta water.
- In a large sauté pan over medium heat, sweat the shallot in the olive oil until soft. Add the pepperoncini and sauté until the aromas are released.
- Increase the heat to medium-high, add the wine and simmer until the alcohol evaporates, which will take around two or three minutes. Add 60ml of the reserved pasta water and the tomatoes and heat to just below a boil.
- > Remove from the heat, add the pasta and toss to coat. Add the prawns and

- half of the pesto and toss gently. Taste and add more if needed.
- > Add more pasta water if needed to smooth out the sauce.
- > Garnish with the reserved basil leaves.
