SEABOURN PURSUIT REACHES MAJOR CONSTRUCTION MILESTONE

The latest ship to join the Seabourn fleet, Seabourn Pursuit, has reached a significant construction milestone as the hull is relocated for final outfitting. The ship's hull was moved 1,200 nautical miles to the T. Mariotti shipyard in Genoa, Italy and marks the latest step towards completion.

Seabourn Pursuit is scheduled to launch in 2023. She will become the cruise line's second purpose-built expedition ship - and sister to Seabourn Venture. Featuring a number of advanced technologies and the expertise of a 26-person team, passengers will be able to make the most of their destinations.

Complimentary expedition offerings will be available on board, including trips on Zodiac boats, hikes, nature walks, scuba diving, and snorkelling. Two custombuilt submarines will also be available to guests at selected destinations.

Josh Leibowitz, President of Seabourn, said: "This is such an exciting milestone as this means we are one step closer to the completion of Seabourn Pursuit.

"I am grateful for everyone who has been working so hard to get to this point, and I look forward to seeing her come more to life in the months ahead as she enters this next phase of the construction process."



When I booked this holiday - what would be my eighth with P&O Cruises - I wasn't quite sure what to expect. I'd resigned myself to the fact that cruising wasn't going to be what I was used to, but decided that, for the first time since 2019, it was time to set sail.

I'll happily admit there were times when I questioned whether it would all be worth it for a three-night jaunt to Zeebrugge. Ever the travel addict, I decided that no matter how much nasal swabbing and form filling was required of me, this holiday was going to happen. And I'm so glad it did.

BOARDING

Armed with paperwork ranging from my covid vaccination certificate to e-tickets, the boarding process began in Southampton. In the spirit of total honesty, this was the part of the cruise I was looking forward to the least. Usually, the terminal is a hive of excitement, but with the requirement to produce a negative covid test performed at port before being allowed to board, this was replaced with a degree of uncertainty.

That said, I found the whole process to be very efficient, taking a little over an hour from parking the car to stepping into my cabin. I'd urge everyone to stick to their allocated boarding time - arrivals



are staggered to manage the flow of people, it's not a ploy to give some passengers priority access to the buffet!

Once on board, my key card was waiting at my cabin, where I arrived to find the door sealed with a sanitisation label. One of the biggest differences I noticed was the muster drill. The days of standing out on a windy deck, lifejacket in hand are long gone - all we had to do was register at our muster station and watch an in-cabin safety video. Job done!






CONCLUSION

ONBOARD POLICIES

M ask wearing was optional throughout the ship, unless you were visiting the medical centre, Headliners Theatre or The Studio. That said, staff wore masks at all times. Food and drink is no longer permitted in the theatre, but I could just about manage 45 minutes without a pina colada and slice of pizza. Hand washing is actively encouraged outside the Horizon Restaurant, where most items are no longer self-service. There's also table service only in the bars and cafes.

Booking for the shows was easy using the My Holiday app, which is more of a website than an app, but worked just as well. We joined a virtual queue to dine in the Peninsular Restaurant; a buzzer notified us when our table was ready and while the wait times were a little longer than I would have liked, I can think of worse ways to kill time than sipping a drink in the Crow's Nest!

LOOKING FORWARD


My cruising addiction well and truly revived, I'll be taking another trip on Iona in just a few weeks' time. Since my short break on Britannia, P&O Cruises announced changes to their testing requirements; instead of being tested at port, I'll need to take an at-home lateral flow test (which I've already ordered and received), register the result and be issued a Fit to Fly



certificate to show at port. At least this time, I'll be able to make the 220mile trip to Southampton safe in the knowledge I can board once I arrive.






INTRODUCING

AMBIENCE CAPTAIN HUGH MAYNARD

It's not every day that a new British cruise line comes around. Ambassador is the first to launch since 2010 and their flagship, Ambience, recently set sail on her maiden voyage. In this exclusive interview, we speak to the first captain of Ambience, Captain Hugh Maynard, about his life on board and what guests can expect from Ambassador Cruise Line.



Luckily, being a Captain for the first time is not being thrown in at the deep end. A lot of training and mentoring goes into the process so once we're let loose with a ship, we've already had the opportunity to manoeuvre the ship many times as Staff Captain and as Juniors under the watchful eye of the Captain. Also these days simulator training is taken, so you can practise in realistic conditions, but you can't do any damage.

Ship handling is personally my favourite part of the job, especially when it all goes to plan, but you always have to have a plan B at hand.

The worst part of the job is the paperwork side of things. My focus is

always the safety of the crew and guests onboard the ship, but the 21st century has brought with it an endless stream of bureaucracy and red tape which wasn't there when I first went to sea in the late seventies!

WHAT DOES AN AVERAGE DAY LOOK LIKE FOR THE CAPTAIN OF A SHIP?

I'm usually on the Bridge before sunrise, an hour or so before the ship enters a port, liaising with the pilot and the port authorities to make sure everything is in order before we make our arrival alongside.

When the pilot boards the ship outside the harbour, we have a discussion on the Bridge about the manoeuvre and nearly always we'll agree that I'll have control and drive the ship. The pilot

will give advice, if needed, about the port and any unusual tidal influences, new obstructions, traffic movement etc although these days there aren't many new ports in my book!

Once I've got the ship safely alongside, tied up, and the officials are onboard doing all the clearance, I'll go and check my emails. There are usually a lot of them in the inbox to work through and that usually takes about two hours of my day, then I'm free to walk the ship and chat with our guests.

I always like to have a little walk along the quayside to see what the ship is looking like on the outside and check the draft marks to check that my Chief Officer is calculating our stability correctly. In addition to these routines, we also have daily

inspections, meetings and drills to carry out, so there's always something to attend to.

After lunch, I usually like to take a stroll ashore, I share this relaxation time equally with my Staff Captain as one of us has to be on board at all times. I know I'm the Captain, but I like my Staff Captain to get ashore as much as possible too, it's a good way to de-stress.

When I'm back on board, in the afternoon it's usually not too long before we depart, so it's another quick check of the dreaded emails to keep up to date, and then onto the Bridge to do the whole operation in reverse before we leave.

Once safely outside and the pilot is happily on his way back inside the port in his boat, I'll hand the watch over to my Officers. I have two Deck Officers, each on a four-hour watch around the clock along with two lookouts.

After I've left my night orders for the watchkeepers and left the Bridge, my time is my own until the whole process is repeated the next day.

Our guests have a desire to travel and our ships will provide that home-from-home feeling. They'll offer friendly crew creating a 'community at sea', whilst giving all guests room to breathe and that feeling of familiarity that will welcome them back time and time again.

AMBASSADOR CRUISE LINE WILL SAIL FROM A NUMBER OF REGIONAL DEPARTURE PORTS ACROSS THE UK. WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO OFFER THE OPTION OF NO-FLY SAILINGS TO YOUR GUESTS?

Ambassador's aim is to provide the holiday our guests deserve and have worked hard for. They're predominantly 50-plus and are looking for a stress-free experience.

We will be able to sail from ports including Newcastle, Dundee, Belfast, Liverpool, Bristol and Falmouth, so widespread across the UK, making our cruises a lot more accessible to those who may not find London Tilbury as easy to travel to as others.

WHICH OF THE ITINERARIES PLANNED FOR AMBIENCE ARE YOU MOST LOOKING FORWARD TO SAILING? IS THERE ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD YOU HAVEN'T YET VISITED, BUT WOULD LIKE TO?

I'm a mountain nut and never happier when I'm roaming around in the hills, so anywhere with vertical bits of land suits me.

I'm originally an Essex boy so it's pretty flat where I grew up, but now I live in the Rocky Mountains which is fantastic. For this reason I'm very much looking forward to exploring Norway again - I know some good climbs if anybody is interested.

For the future, I'd like to go to South Africa. 43 years at sea and I've never called there!







Kew Gardens meets War of the Worlds is the best way to describe this attraction, where you're sure to get your flora fix alongside a few futuristic extras for added interest. Spanning over 101 hectares, you'll once again need to exercise some self-restraint. By this point you're likely to have had your fill of bird's-eye views, so we'd recommend dividing your time between the Flower Dome and Floral Fantasy. Brightly coloured petals cascade from every angle and the magnitude of the displays are quite something, so prepare for your camera roll to reach maximum capacity.

To tick another one of those 'won't get anywhere else' experiences off your list, set aside a few hours for the Singapore Night Safari. Hailed as the world's first nocturnal wildlife park, once your eyes have adjusted to the darkness you'll enjoy spotting hundreds of species as

you venture through the jungle. Take your pick from one of four walking routes, or hop aboard a guided tram or buggy ride. Either way, it's a truly unique adventure.





Great food is woven into the very fabric of Singapore, and we'd urge

you to shun meticulously constructed dishes in favour of something more rugged. The hawker food experience is one that's slowly migrated over to our shores, but its true authenticity lies here in south-east Asia. In centuries gone by, hawkers were where the migrant population huddled to provide quick, affordable meals,

pavements, town squares and parks all lending themselves to serving up the

most magnificent of meals. These days, the hawker ethos remains the same, but the surroundings are all the more civilised. Traders are now permitted to gather under one roof - you'll find around 100 of these dotted across the city - and the best tip we can offer is to locate the one with the longest queue and join it.

Should you find yourself in Chinatown, then your patience is likely to be rewarded at Hawker Chan. This unassuming eatery was the first hawker

in the world to be awarded a Michelin star. The dish that earned this coveted title is a chicken and rice combination; the sauce is freshly prepared every morning, where manual braising makes for a sticky, sumptuous dish worthy of just a fistful of your Singapore dollars.

As far as drinks go, the Singapore Sling is a must-try experience. It has

your patience is likely

graced many a cocktail menu since its conception over 100 years ago, and you should grab the opportunity to sip on the real thing with both hands. Venture to Raffles Hotel and perch yourself in Long Bar, with its rough-around-the-edges level of sophistication. Flanked by traditional Mayan decor, lower yourself into a wicker chair and brush the discarded peanut shells off the table as a keen mixologist gets to work creating this iconic tipple. Ngiam Tong Boon designed the Singapore Sling back in 1915 at a time when women drinking alcohol in public was a most definite no-no, its fruit juice-like exterior and clear alcohol proving deceptive enough for any curious onlooker. Gin, pineapple, lime juice, curaçao and bénédictine are all expertly combined, as grenadine and cherry liqueur provide a blush colour. This is a drink that's best savoured slowly. You have come all this way, after all.










STAVANGER, NORWAY





LESSER-KNOWN CRUISE PORTS

The excitement of booking a cruise often starts with glancing down an itinerary, where, more often than not, our excited eyes can't help but hone in on the ports we're familiar with. But for every Barcelona or Rome you encounter, there also lies a less renowned destination just waiting to be discovered.

Whether you unearth these hidden gems as soon as you disembark, or they glimmer faintly in the distance beyond the confines of the port, there are plenty of lesser-known European destinations deserving of their place on your cruise itinerary.



VILLEFRANCHE, France

The south of France. It's where the high life is well and truly lived, whether that's through rolling dice in the casinos of Monte Carlo, or sipping a glass of perfectly chilled champagne as exquisite yachts float by. Villefranche is a slice of heaven on these not-too-distant shores - a quiet, unassuming port, shy in comparison to these more confident neighbours.

At its core, Villefranche is a fishing village adorned with picture-perfect scenery. Terracotta buildings cling to the cliffside, intercepted by a maze of cobbled streets that will challenge even the surest sense of direction. For a few hours at least, Villefranche holds its own as a captivating cruise



destination. The climate is fine, the way of life is slow and the waters sparkling - what more could you want than that?

And you can't help but be compelled by the razzamatazz of the French Riviera, the good news is the bright lights of Nice and Cannes only lie about an hour away.



OLDEN, Norway

Bergen and Stavanger remain firm cruise destination favourites, but Olden is finding its feet on a growing number of itineraries, including those from P&O Cruises. Squatting at the southern end of Nordfjord, it's everything you'd expect from a fjord - and more.

As soon as you step ashore, Argostoli's helpfully arranged grid pattern will make it easy to get around.

Traipsing the streets of this charming, pristine town is nothing short of a pleasure, with restaurants and cafes enticing you to just sit and watch the world go by. To get in on the action, head to the pedestrianised Platia Vallianou, or Central Square, a hive for people watching and soaking up the Greek sun.

If you're lucky enough to be in port when the fishing boats return with their morning catch, head down to the harbour to catch a glimpse of one of

> nature's spectacles. Sea turtles usually appear, hoping to snatch a morsel of food, the glassy, crystalline waters making them easy to spot.





LA CORUÑA, Spain

Northern Spanish ports usually conjure up images of Bilbao and Santander and understandably so. But La Coruña is very much the new kid on the block, despite its origins being firmly rooted in the past.

This historic city's position next to the Atlantic Ocean offers something different to the usual Mediterranean



shores. Head slightly inland and you'll uncover the Old City, complete with its Romanesque streets and squares, and architecture that's about as Spanish as you could imagine.

La Coruña also hosts an expansive seafront, best enjoyed with a slowpaced stroll. If you've got your heart set on seeing the city's famous Tower

CARTAGENA, Spain

N ot to be confused with its Colombian counterpart, Cartagena is a city in the Murcia region of south-east Spain. Its strategic position has made the port invaluable to the Spanish mainland over the centuries, but cruise visitors are the ones who have more recently reaped the rewards.

Step ashore and you'll be greeted with a clean, quiet city with pockets of pure Spanishness. Glance out over the glistening Med from the canon-lined promenade before venturing further into the city. The Roman Theatre is a sight to behold; it was only rediscovered in 1988 having lay unexcavated for more than 2,000 years. An extensive restoration has drawn visitors from far and wide, earning the museum the title of Murcia's most visited.

If you haven't already had your fill of gastronomic delights on board, Cartagena is the place to indulge. Perhaps unsurprisingly, fish is the order of the day here; the Med lies just an arm's length away, serving up some of the freshest seafood you could ever imagine. And while you're at it, wash your meal down with Cartagena's typical asiático. Made from coffee, condensed milk, Licor 43 and cinnamon, the coffee accompaniment will put the spring back in your step that you will need to carry on exploring.





LA SPEZIA, Italy




whole fridge was full of Diet Coke! This is when I started to see the service really shine through.

PAPPARDELLE ALLA BOLOGNESE

Take your spaghetti bolognese to the next level with this exclusive recipe from NCL. It's rich, it's sumptuous and it's an all-round crowd pleaser.

Serves 4

INGREDIENTS

- > 400g pappardelle pasta
- > **500g** of mince, a mix of beef, pork and veal
- > 2 garlic cloves
- > 1 large onion, finely chopped
- > 2 carrots, peeled and finely chopped
- > 2 celery sticks, finely chopped
- > A knob of butter

> 1 tablespoon of olive oil

- > 2 tins peeled and crushed plum tomatoes
- > **125ml** red wine
- > 400ml chicken stock
- > A pinch of salt
- > A bouquet garni of rosemary and thyme

METHOD

- > Preheat the oven to 190°C.
- > To prepare the bolognese sauce, heat a skillet and add half the oil and all the butter.
- > Add the vegetables and garlic to the skillet and sauté for five to seven minutes on medium heat.
- > Add the bouquet garni and cook for three to four minutes, then set aside.
- > In a separate large pot, heat the remaining oil.
- > Lay all the meats on a tray and lightly season before adding to the skillet.
- > Stir occasionally in order to break up the meat and cook until browned.
- > Add the meat to the vegetables and roast until it sticks to the bottom of the pot.

- > Add the wine and reduce.
- > Add the tomato paste, roast well, then add the plum tomatoes.
- > Cook on low heat until reduced and then add the chicken stock a little at a time. Gently simmer for one hour.
- > Bring the sauce to the right consistency and adjust the seasoning.
- > Boil the pappardelle pasta until al dente, approximately two minutes, and drain.
- > Add the pasta to the bolognese sauce and bring to the correct consistency, adding water if necessary.
- > Adjust the seasoning and remove the sauce from the stove. Finish the dish with extra virgin olive oil, parmesan cheese and chopped parsley.
