ARVIA'S ESCAPE ROOM PROMISES UNIQUE LIVE-ACTION ADVENTURE




urther details of the first P&O Cruises escape room have been announced, as Arvia's maiden voyage is just a matter of months away. Mission Control promises a unique, immersive experience, combining an escape game with submarine simulation and an intense live-action story.

Groups of up to 10 people can form a team of marine explorers and underwater detectives. On board the fictional Arvia II, and under the expert guidance of Dr. Melissa Ryan, teams must overcome danger and solve puzzles at every turn.

Realistic 3D surroundings will bring the adventure to life, taking passengers to the depths of ocean canyons where they will encounter sunken cities and underwater creatures. Anyone who is successful in their mission will join Dr. Ryan's team and graduate as a fully-fledged member of the Marine Research Institute.

Phil Yeomans, Director of Entertainment at P&O Cruises, said: "We wanted to create something brand new and we believe this is the first of its kind in the world. We took the escape room (a really popular, fun, family activity) and a simulator, and mashed the two together to create a fantastic submarine experience. Boarding Arvia II is like being in the biggest blockbuster movie out there."

Entertainment Innovation Manager Michael Kelly continued: "The idea is that you step off Arvia and into Arvia II, where our top scientist Dr. Ryan sends you off on a research mission, diving deep down beneath the ship.



"Of course, things go wrong along the way and you have to figure out how to solve the problems to complete the mission. Mission Control completely puts the audience at the centre of the story. You really are on board this submarine, controlling it, steering and navigating the dive, flipping the switches and monitoring the sonar... you're in control at every stage of this incredible journey."

Arvia's maiden voyage is a 14-night sailing to the Canary Islands, departing Southampton on 9 December 2022.

INGER KLEIN THORHAUGE CAPTAIN OF CUNARD'S QUEEN ANNE

When Cunard's new ship, Queen Anne, embarks on her maiden voyage in January 2024, she will do so with Captain Inger Klein Thorhauge at the helm. Captain Inger has already made her mark during her 25 years with Cunard, becoming the cruise line's first female captain. We caught up with her to discuss her career and what guests can expect from Cunard's fourth Queen.

QUEEN ANNE



WHERE DID YOUR CAREER AS A CAPTAIN **BEGIN, AND AT WHAT AGE DID YOU REALISE IT'S WHAT YOU WANTED TO DO?**

My time at sea started at the age of 16 on a cargo ship where I was a stewardess - I quickly realised that I really enjoyed the sailing part, but not so much the cleaning! So, I waited to pursue a career at sea and it was then I realised I needed to pick the area I wanted to specialise in. I worked my way up through the ranks, before achieving my Master's licence in 1994. My career as Captain

started in 2010 on Queen Victoria, which I was very honoured and proud of.

WHAT IS YOUR FAVOURITE PORT OF CALL, AND IS **THERE ANYWHERE YOU** HAVEN'T PREVIOUSLY SAILED TO THAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO VISIT?

I don't really have a favourite port of call - it is more the entire world I enjoy exploring - as each area is so special in

its own way. I have been lucky enough to sail around the world several times and by now have explored what I have wanted to see. Now it is time to discover even more of the wonderful locations we visit with Cunard and our guests.

YOU HAVE BEEN WITH CUNARD FOR OVER TWO DECADES, HAVE YOU EVER HAD THE **OPPORTUNITY TO CAPTAIN A NEW SHIP BEFORE?**

I have not captained a brand-new ship before so this is such a privilege. All the necessary protocols have to be set up from the start, so there is a lot of work that will need to be done prior to taking Queen Anne on her maiden voyage.

WHICH PART OF QUEEN ANNE ARE YOU LOOKING FORWARD TO SEEING FIRST?

The entire ship to be honest. As this is a brand-new ship, all of it will be exciting to see. Like many, I have seen some of the exquisite designs but to see Queen Anne in all her glory and to be one

of the first to do so will be a great honour.

WHAT ARE THE FIRST TASKS YOU DO IN THE **MORNING AS CAPTAIN?**

If it's a day when we are in port, our arrival time will dictate when I wake up. A 6am arrival will usually mean I'm up long before dawn to help navigate the ship through whatever local conditions we face. On a sea day, I'm typically up around 5:30am. I'm always on

the Bridge during arrival and departure from a port, and often on days at sea as well. I will go through all the tracks with the navigator and approve them. The last task I do before I head to bed is check the speed of the ship.

HOW OFTEN DO YOU HAVE THE CHANCE TO INTERACT WITH GUESTS?

It's important to remember that the cruise industry is a hospitality business, so I see myself as a host. We generally hold a number of big parties during

our guests' time on board and I walk through the ship once or twice a day. When we're at sea, I will make a midday announcement about our navigational progress and let them know about weather conditions.

For me, hearing guests' feedback that they have enjoyed their experience at the end of their voyage makes me so proud of the entire crew.

WHAT, IN YOUR OPINION, MAKES THE EXPERIENCE OF SAILING WITH CUNARD



An Unforgettable Rail Journey from Vancouver to Banff

Every time we sell a Cruise & Stay holiday with a Rocky Mountaineer train journey included in the itinerary, I always get excited, because there is just something so special about this trip. So, when I was given the chance to experience the train for myself, I was absolutely over the moon (or over the mountains, should I say).

set off to Vancouver, where I would embark the Rocky Mountaineer train on a journey called First Passage to the West. This is certainly one of our most popular itineraries, however, most of our guests take the train in the other direction to end up in Vancouver to board a stunning Alaska cruise.

Vancouver is a beautiful city; they really take pride in the trees and how fresh and alive they keep the surroundings. Vancouver gave a small glimpse of what lay ahead on my journey, because as I looked out past the waterfront, the skyline featured some impressive mountains. There is an activity I would recommend for anyone beginning their Canadian adventure in Vancouver: FlyOver Canada. This is a ride created by the same people who designed Sorin at Disney World, a tame simulator that gives the illusion of flying over the vast Canadian landscapes, and it even features an appearance from the Rocky Mountaineer train itself! I was so impressed that we will be including tickets to this activity on all our Cruise & Stay packages with a stop in Vancouver.

After a couple of nights exploring the city, it was finally time to board the Rocky Mountaineer train and see what this whole trip was about. My suitcases were collected from my hotel, and I was given luggage tags that would see my luggage through the whole train journey. The next time I saw my bag it was

waiting for me in my hotel room in Kamloops.

THE START OF AN ADVENTURE

When I arrived at the Rocky Mountaineer station, the train stood with grandeur. There were red carpets laid at each of the carriage doors, and large flags hung from the train

where people were gathering to take photos before boarding. The first thing that struck me was how large the train is; the carriages are mostly two floors with large domed roofs, so they really are massive! When first boarding the train, I was greeted by our carriage attendants and shown to my seat. I was very fortunate to be travelling in GoldLeaf, the upgraded carriage onboard the train. My seat was a large comfy leather seat with electric controls to recline and adjust its position, but what I wasn't expecting was the additional feature of it being heated!

As the train began to roll away from the station in Vancouver towards our mountainous destinations, the team of train hosts began their work. First up was tea, coffee and croissants served upstairs in our seats as we

Not long afterwards, I was shown downstairs to the dining area. This is where the GoldLeaf service shines brightly; this carriage is split across two floors, with the dining area on a separate floor from my seat. It was good to have different places to go throughout the day,

which breaks up the journey nicely.

A DAY TO REMEMBER

Breakfast onboard the train was amazing, and if you see the tiny galleys the chefs work in, you will be more than impressed. The dining tables were set up with tablecloths and silverware. The menu had an impressive variety of breakfast options such as eggs benedict, cheese and spinach soufflé,

and pancakes. The service and the quality of the food was faultless, and I would say cruise line quality; this is high praise for me because cruise lines, in my opinion, have the highest standards of food in the travel industry. I couldn't make up my mind between the eggs and the pancakes, so they brought me both - just an example of how attentive the onboard service truly was.

After breakfast, I headed back upstairs

to watch the scenery as it began to change. If you are travelling from Vancouver to Banff, you will start in a flatter landscape that develops to become more and more mountainous the further you travel. If you undertake the trip in reverse, you will start in the mountains and journey to the coast. I really loved watching

the scenery become more and more dramatic so I would personally recommend taking the route I took, so start with an Alaska cruise then join the Rocky Mountaineer in Vancouver through to Banff and fly home from Calgary.

This goes without saying, but the scenery was just incredible and is what this trip is all about. You are travelling through amazing feats of nature. The train moves slowly; it is not like a commuter train, it takes its time to meander through the mountains. You are completely submerged in the scenery, allowing you to take amazing photos from any angle.

Lunchtime onboard the Rocky Mountaineer is a treat, the food is of a very high standard, with a good variety so there is something for everyone. The lunchtime service is set amongst a now beautiful mountainous backdrop, and I was served bread, followed by a tableshared starter, a la carte mains, and a dessert. I was onboard the train for a whole day, so the lunchtime dinner service in GoldLeaf is a great opportunity to have a change of scenery, and there is a different, more social atmosphere as people move into the dining area.

Another benefit of the GoldLeaf carriage is the outdoor viewing deck, this was one of my favourite spots on the trip and it's the perfect place to go for photo opportunities. The train came to a stop so that we could wave to another Rocky

> Mountaineer train coming in the opposite direction. We were all hanging out of the train ready to wave, and all of the GoldLeaf customers on the other train were out waving at us from their viewing platforms, it was

> > really special.

A common misconception about Rocky Mountaineer is that you sleep on the trains, but that is not the case. You are only onboard Rocky Mountaineer during daylight hours. The train will stop at specific stations overnight and the passengers are taken to their respective hotels. This whole operation is amazing and Rocky Mountaineer have got it spot on! As I got off the train, I was handed my room key for the evening, took a short coach ride to my hotel, and went straight to my room to find my luggage was there waiting. The next morning, half an hour or so before I set off for the train, somebody came along to collect my bag and take it to the next hotel.

The two days onboard the train were perfect for me. I watched as the mountains became larger and larger and the landscape became increasingly vast. I saw waterfalls, rivers, rapids, glaciers, mighty birds, reindeer and even a bear! I honestly could go on about how amazing it all looked, but it is definitely one of those things you do have to see in person to get the full impact.

ENDING ON A HIGH

Finishing in Banff was a highlight of the trip, I absolutely loved it. Standing on Banff high street, and looking to each end, it is just perfectly framed by two giant mountains. The town has a ski town vibe with cosy firepits and wooden lodges. Banff is just a short drive from Lake Louise, which is a complete must-visit. Lake Louise is one of the most photographed landmarks in Canada because it is just so beautiful. Lakes in Canada are absolutely nothing like lakes in the UK - they are humongous. The most iconic thing about Lake Louise becomes apparent while I was still onboard the train and approached Banff National Park - the water became a bright, beautiful turquoise blue.

Before I set off on the Rocky Mountaineer, so many people referred to it as a bucket list trip. So, is this a trip that I think you need to add to your bucket list? Absolutely! If you are an adventurer, explorer, if you love nature and scenery, then this is a fabulous way of exploring a breathtaking part of the world.

S cenic cruising isn't some guilty secret that cruise lines attempt to disguise - and nor should they! It will be prominently labelled on your itinerary, and can take on any number of guises, with 'cruise by' and the ever-so-simple 'cruising' followed by the destination name among the most popular.

No matter how your chosen cruise line refers to it, your experience

will be much the same. Scenic cruising, rather helpfully, does precisely as the name suggests you will sail through spectacular scenery, which you can appreciate from the comfort of your ship without setting foot ashore. It's all about getting a different perspective on the world, and a view of those places that would be near-on impossible to fully appreciate with your feet firmly on land.

As with any aspect of travelling, scenic cruising is what you make of it. Watch the world go by from the solace of a hot tub, or stand out on the deck with a pair of binoculars to really immerse yourself in your surroundings - it really is up to you!

Yes, the atrium is impressive as it is on many other ships I've been on, but the floor-to-ceiling glass windows spanning three decks mean that whatever mountain you're passing, or gorge you sail past, you'll get a crystal-clear view from lona. One of my highlights was a lunch we enjoyed with an incredible view of the ship's wake in Pearl Restaurant, and one of my personal favourites, the Crow's Nest, certainly

My Experience

've had two quite different experiences of scenic cruising. The first was on board the Princess Cruises ship Emerald Princess, where I sailed from Buenos Aires in Argentina to Santiago, Chile. The scenic cruising element of this trip took us to the Amalia Glacier and Cape Horn, which was complemented by commentary from onboard experts.

The information was as rich as it was varied; we were told about the formation of the Amalia Glacier, the geology of the region in which we were sailing and an overview of its maritime history. The experts were also on hand to tell us about any wildlife we might encounter and rest assured, we saw our fair share of birds and marine life. Thankfully, they were there to point out anything we might have missed, and identify species as they came into view.


What I'd initially perceived as filler material for our epic South American



journey proved to be one of the highlights of the entire trip - it's fair to say I was sold on scenic cruising!

My most recent adventure took me to Norway on P&O Cruises Iona, a ship that has been specifically built for this part of the world. The Norwegian Fjords are the perfect example of the journey being just as important as the destination; while our land-based stops of Stavanger, Alesund, Olden and Haugesund were each endearing in their own right, it was the rolling scenery that really stole the show.

Innvikfjorden and Nordfjord were both



didn't disappoint as we weaved our way through the Fjords.

As we entered the scenic cruising element of the trip, the expanse of the sea took a sidestep, and allowed the land to take centre stage. Usually, at this point, I would have been marvelling at a shipping trawler bobbing about in the distance, or trying to figure out which landmass glimmered on the horizon, but scenic cruising is all about seeing nature at its best. The rise and fall of the waves are replaced with the calmest of waters inside the Fjord, millpondlike enough to mirror the incredible landscapes.

This particular scenic cruising journey started in Innvikfjorden, a small arm of Nordfjord. Quaint wooden houses clung to the cliffside and the Olden shoreline soon melted into the distance, resembling a watercolour painting as we sailed away. It was the perfect prelude to what awaited us. Nordfjord has been welcoming cruise ships since the 1880s, and its enduring appeal hasn't waned during this time. From the water that cascaded so fiercely down a cliff face that we could hear it from our cabin, to snow-sprinkled mountains that felt within touching distance, Nordfjord served up its fair share of spectacles.

There were no on-deck announcements during this scenic cruise; instead, I just sat back (this time from the comfort of my balcony) and watched the stunning surroundings float by. For a ship of its size, lona managed to sail the Fjords with the grace they deserve.

What really struck me about scenic cruising this time around was the silence, which couldn't have been easy to achieve with some 3,600 excitable passengers on board. The only sound was that of Iona creating barely-there ripples, which gently lapped the shoreline as if they



had all the time in the world, only occasionally interrupted by the roar of a waterfall or melodic birdsong. Most balconies were filled with eagle-eyed cruisers, each pointing out a natural marvel their companion might not have spotted. It was an incredible experience and one I'd recommend to anyone who can't get enough of just sitting back and letting Mother Nature show off a little.

Ambitions for the Future

y appetite for scenic cruising fully awakened, next on my wishlist is Fred. Olsen, which is one cruise line that places considerable emphasis on 'the joy of the journey'. For me, this sums up scenic cruising perfectly and is something they expertly craft into many itineraries.

If the past few years have taught us anything, it's how to fully appreciate exactly what's on our doorstep - and what better way to do it than on a scenic cruise? Fred. Olsen encourages exploration of home territories such as the Orkney and Shetland Isles. Marine conservation charity ORCA are on board these particular sailings, helping cruisers spot and identify marine life as they navigate these northern shores.

There's also a scenic Ireland itinerary that's caught my eye, which takes in quintessential Irish vistas. Having already conquered the fjords of Chile and Norway on a scenic cruise, the Irish glacial fjord of Lough Swilly seems the next logical step.

If you haven't yet given scenic cruising a try, I'd highly recommend it. There's nothing finer than sitting back and watching the scenery roll by, without having to so much as lift a finger. I can think of worse ways to spend a holiday.







here's always been something quite special about a British cruise line. Ambassador recently became part of this elite crew as the first to launch since 2010 and their flagship, Ambience, is their 'first lady of the sea'. This 1,400-capacity ship is aimed at the over-50s, no-fly cruise market and

promises the warmest of welcomes from the friendliest of crews. Being a fair few years short of this age bracket, I wasn't quite sure what to expect from Ambience - but as the saying goes, age is only a number, and I couldn't wait to experience everything she had to offer.

One of the first things I noticed was the not-so-subtle nods to the London scene throughout the ship. The main atrium is aptly named Centre Court, while SW19 is the perfect place to sip away on an expertly crafted drink - the only thing missing was the strawberries and cream (oh, and the tennis...) One of the real highlights for me was Borough Market; located on deck 12, it's a buffet-style

restaurant where there's no such thing as too much choice. Curry, pizza and a good old roast dinner - what more could you want?

Fear not, there's still a formal dining room that serves up some of the finest food I've ever tasted onboard a ship. Buckingham Restaurant is where you'll find traditional cruise ship

styling, attentive service and the more

formal dining experience we've all come to know and love.

I am, however, old enough to remember the good old days of the baked Alaska parade, where diners wave perfectly starched napkins in the air as wide-smiled waiters make their way through the maze of the dining room. It's a cruising

tradition that has slowly waned over the years, but one that Ambassador have



been keen to revive - and we, as diners, were only too happy to oblige.

The Observatory Bar at the front of the ship is also well worth a mention.



PRINCESS CRUISES CROWN GRILL'S BLACK AND BLUE ONION SOUP

Try your hand at making this passenger favourite at home. It's a hearty starter that's great to share, based on traditional French onion soup recipes and enlivened with flavours of whiskey and Roquefort cheese.

Serves 2

For the soup:

- > **1** teaspoon olive oil
- > 2 white onions, sliced
- > 1 teaspoon fresh thyme leaves
- > 2 tablespoons of Jack Daniels
- > 1 litre of clear brown chicken stock (substitute for vegetable stock to make vegetarian)
- > Salt and pepper to taste

For the Roquefort crust:

- > Half a loaf of white or French bread
- > **1** garlic bulb, cut across the grain
- > Olive oil
- > 225g Roquefort cheese, crumbled



Method

- > Sauté the onions in olive oil over a medium-low heat, stirring occasionally until browned. Do not burn. Add thyme and cook for an extra two minutes.
- > Add the Jack Daniels. If the mixture doesn't ignite from the stove, light carefully with a match and let the alcohol burn off.



- > Add the stock and simmer for one hour, over a moderate heat, allowing the onions to stew.
- > Season to taste and ladle into ovenproof bowls.



- > To make the Roquefort crust, pre-heat the oven to 180°C.
- > Cut the bread into rings, sized to fit into the ovenproof bowls. Rub the cut garlic bulb across the bread.
- > Place onto baking sheets and drizzle with olive oil. Bake in the oven until crisp and golden brown.
- > Top each soup portion with a round of toasted bread and a thick layer of Roquefort cheese. Place under the grill until the cheese is melted and lightly browned and serve immediately.




