

Queen Anne, the fourth ship to join the Cunard fleet, is set to feature a number of inspiring outdoor spaces designed to connect guests to their surroundings.

Each area on board will have its own distinctive look and feel, including The Pavilion which boasts a specially-designed retractable glass roof. Home to a central stage that will host live performances and cinema screenings, the space will span two decks and be a hive of activity throughout the day and into the evening.

The Pavilion Wellness Studio will make its debut on Queen Anne and is set to encompass an array of Mareel Wellness and Beauty activities. These include regular fitness sessions, such as yoga classes and mindful meditation.

Queen Anne will also feature an aft pool, where there will be plenty of opportunities to enjoy al fresco nibbles throughout the day. A full waitress service ensures guests will always have a freshly shaken cocktail in their hand.

Meanwhile, Grills Terrace will be a space exclusive to guests staying in the Princess and Queens Grill suites. Accessible using a suite room key, the area includes two infinity hot tubs with horizon views and is the perfect place to sit back and relax.

Cunard's Queen Anne is due to launch in January 2024, when she will set sail for Lisbon before undertaking her maiden season in the Canary Islands and the Caribbean.






Oh, the Caribbean. Once a bucket-list destination, it's now opened up those sun-kissed arms to the world, and we're only too happy to embrace it.

Kick back and relax



incredibly infectious about the Caribbean as each island delivers soul in spades - and you can't help but



While Trinidad and Tobago might be co-dependent island nations - the siamese twins of the Caribbean, if you will



But with average temperatures of around 28 degrees celsius whenever you choose to travel, we know where we'd rather be...







Food and drink can make or break a cruise, and Lukas Campestrini is the person responsible for making sure everything is ship-shape (pun intended).

On P&O Cruises alone, there are 132 dining and bar venues, so needless to say this is no easy task. We caught up with him to find out more about what goes on behind the scenes to deliver a memorable experience across the P&O Cruises fleet.

WHAT DOES YOUR ROLE ENTAIL AS FOOD AND BEVERAGE DIRECTOR?

I mainly look after our F&B (food and beverage) offerings on board, which includes all our restaurants, bars and so on. We are there to provide our

guests with a unique experience that will allow them to discover the diversity of our dining and drink options.

We always need to keep in mind the British taste palate; my team and I focus heavily on understanding our customers' needs, what they like, what really works well, what doesn't work so well, and what

we need to adjust. We spend a lot of time looking at customer insights, market trends, customer satisfaction and the comments we receive to understand what new trends are popping up in the UK and also around the globe.

We are the ones who are responsible for designing or creating new

concepts across all our ships, as well as maintaining and adapting existing ones while continuously adjusting the product. Our ultimate goal is to deliver a food and beverage proposition that all our guests will love, while also bearing in mind the destinations they will be

> travelling to and bringing them to life.

Another part of my role is to look at the future, what the next generation of food and beverage concepts will be, what our guests will love and making sure we remain relevant for years to come.

HOW HAVE FOOD AND DRINK OPTIONS ON BOARD CRUISE SHIPS CHANGED DURING YOUR TIME IN THE INDUSTRY?

Over the years, I've seen the food and travel industries make a real shift towards healthy eating and food sustainability. It's a big topic for us, especially from the perspective of how we use pre-packaged foods and singleuse plastics.

We are also looking more closely at where our food comes from and how sustainable it is. I think plant-based diets are certainly on the up, as is the flexitarian approach to eating. People now tend to eat meat but also turn to plant-based products for some of the time.



I think now more than ever we need to be adaptable to ensure we cater to the needs of different diets and we need to be more agile and provide a greater range of food choices on our menu.

We must develop menus that bring the destinations to life, especially in the cruise industry where in the past there was sometimes just a blanket approach.

Drink options are likewise continuously evolving. People have become more discerning and their taste profiles have changed greatly. We are providing something new for our customers in meeting the British taste palate, while in turn meeting their ever-heightening expectations.

WHAT IS IT THAT YOU THINK SETS **P&O CRUISES APART FROM OTHER CRUISE LINES IN DELIVERING THAT QUINTESSENTIALLY BRITISH FOOD AND DRINK EXPERIENCE?**

I think one thing we do well at P&O Cruises is getting a close understanding of our

guests' preferences. If we spend a lot of time analysing what guests like and what they love, it will tell us where we need to focus our effort and what we need to evolve.

change for us.

was a real step-change for us. First off, we introduced the first gin distillery at sea and developed our own gin, Marabelle, which was superbly received by our customers. We introduced Olive Grove, which is included in the cruise fare and an additional dining option on board Iona, and then we worked with Snowflake to deliver

an extraordinary gelato experience at Ripples, our onboard ice cream parlour. These are just a few examples of how we've taken lona forward to really cater to our guests.

We also do a lot of work with our Local Food Heroes, who help bring destinations to life. We work with Shivi Ramoutar for our Caribbean itineraries, and José Pizarro for our Mediterranean itineraries, who will soon have his own tapas selection in The Glass House giving guests the chance to really experience a Spanish style of food.

We work with Kjartan Skjelde in Norway, who has developed a six-course tasting menu in The Epicurean. It can be quite difficult to get in, as it's sold out on

nearly every cruise. We pick up the ingredients in Stavanger, where all the elements are loaded on the ship before being prepared and cooked. This is something many people haven't experienced before and we are trying to do more of this, bringing local experiences to life.

I think we work hard to understand our guests' preferences and we have the opportunity to provide something new to them by delivering some great modern British flavours as well.

WHICH IS YOUR
FAVOURITE RESTAURANT
AND BAR ON BOARD ANY
OF THE P&O CRUISES
FLEET AND WHY?

That is a tough one. I actually love the new menu in Sindhu. We have completely refreshed it and it really is a fantastic menu.

But, if I had to choose one, it would be The Keel & Cow, our gastropub restaurant. This is currently on board Iona and will also be launched on Arvia. In this restaurant you can really taste and sample a range of incredible steaks for a fraction of the price of the high street. All this is featured alongside our Prime Minister Burger, which I would say is the best burger at sea. The Keel & Cow also has a relaxed, vibrant atmosphere that's really well received by our guests.

When I look at Arvia I will probably have a new favourite, but for now it's the Keel & Cow.

As for my favourite bar, I really like Anderson's Bar on board Iona where we have a huge variety of gin. I love our distillery on Iona, where you can watch the distiller, sit and have a chat with him as he's really knowledgeable and then have your gin masterclass. I also really enjoy our Emerald Bar where we have a cocktail menu that spans the entire globe, which we are now slowly going to implement across the fleet. This has really elevated the cocktail experience

that people had seen previously on P&O Cruises ships. These two bars really stand out for me.

WHAT WOULD YOU SAY IS THE GREATEST LOGISTICAL CHALLENGE THAT YOU FACE WHEN CATERING FOR THOUSANDS OF **PASSENGERS?**

We have many thousands of products on board; we have to make sure they are delivered on time to the vessels, consistently, and ensure we keep up the frequency of deliveries. We need to do this all over the world, so the main challenge is keeping up the exact same specification and quality. It's really important to me that the quality doesn't get compromised.

This takes a substantial amount of planning throughout the year and hard work from our team, supply chain and so on. We need to take into account the sheer number of menus we have on offer and our different concepts to keep the rotations going so guests experience something new every meal of the day.

WHAT PROCESS DO YOU GO THROUGH FROM DECIDING ON A CONCEPT RIGHT THROUGH TO MAKING SURE IT'S FULLY **DELIVERED ON BOARD?**

Once we decide on a concept, we go into the design stages with the architects; it's about finding the right concept, right venue and right atmosphere.

Then we launch into the development process so we can find out exactly what our customers would like to see. We have a development kitchen on site in Southampton, which is where our culinary development team is based full-time and they do all the development for our ships. We will go through several iterations where we engage with our different suppliers and give them a brief in terms of what we're looking for. We also need to keep the ship's different deployments in mind.

Sourcing fresh produce in Southampton is quite simple, and once the ship goes to Italy, Spain et cetera, maintaining the same quality is still relatively simple. As soon as we move to a Caribbean deployment, there's a different level of expectation on Caribbean produce, and

their suppliers work to a very different specification. We really need to establish the best suppliers in the Caribbean or in the US.

We then start to create the menus and will have different tastings until we go to a final tasting, which is when we engage



focus groups. We like to engage with the customers by putting the food in front of them, to understand what they like and get their feedback. The same goes for our beverages. We think carefully about how our drinks will work alongside our food. There is a lot of training on board with our chefs to make sure everyone is familiar with the concepts.

rom the North Sea in the, well, north, to the Swiss Alps in the south, the Rhine serves up everything that is good and great about mainland Europe. As you weave past storybook villages and fairytale castles, all within touching distance, you will soon realise the perfect river cruise is far from a work of fiction.

Here are some of the picture-perfect ports you'll encounter along the way.



REFLECTIONS

Amsterdam

A city with water at its core, it's hardly surprising that Amsterdam features on many river cruise itineraries. Canals plot their way through its hodge-podge of streets, where chocolate box houses stand proud against this otherwise pancake-flat metropolis. Foodies and history buffs will be rewarded in their droves - how lucky you'll be to end up in Old Amsterdam.



Cologne

Germany's fourth-largest city might share its namesake with the fall-back gift for the man in your life, but its offering to river cruisers is far more fragrant. Cologne Cathedral took more than seven centuries to construct, so it seems only fair to while away an hour or two exploring its environs. Reward yourself with a crisp stein of Kolsch before securing your love on Hohenzollern Bridge, more commonly known as Lock Bridge.



Koblenz

Burg Etz above the Moselle River between Koblenz and Trier

Mountains, forests and vineyards - Koblenz doesn't face much competition in the aesthetic stakes. Once the capital of Prussia's Rhine province, and strategically squatted at the confluence of the Moselle and Rhine rivers, it's easy to see why Koblenz has such historical clout. Appreciate all its natural splendour with a trip to Ehrenbreitstein; scaling 120 metres above the Rhine, this fortress is perfectly poised to peer out over this remarkable part of Germany.



Rudesheim

The Rhine serves up some of the world's most famous wine-making regions and in Rudesheim, you can sip on a glass of Riesling, a grape's throw away from where it was made. A quirky encounter awaits at the whimsical Siegfried's Mechanical Music Cabinet, and you simply can't miss out on Drosselgasse, a 15th-century cobbled alleyway measuring just 144 metres long. Encroached by timber structures, you'll find yourself serenaded by the sound of live music and left wondering if you've set foot into your own fairytale - and a trip to the frankly stunning Boosenburg Castle will only cement your suspicions.



Strasbourg

Old meets new, heritage meets multiculturalism - Strasbourg has it all. Be transported back in time to the picturesque Old Town, a puzzle of cobbled streets carved out so they're level with the surrounding waterways, where buildings once home to millers and fishermen now house the quaintest of restaurants, shops and cafes. Strasbourg really sparkles when winter takes hold, welcoming all and sundry round to their place for a good old festive shindig at the word-renowned Christmas markets.



Basel

With France and Germany so close by, it's unsurprising that Basel has had to work hard to forge its own identity. HOURS In Bordeaux

France's sixth-largest city has stunning architecture at its heart and fine wine running through its veins. Just a short hop from the UK, Bordeaux still manages to feel a world away from these shores; it's a perfectly quaffable city, which boasts a sobering history and an intoxicating mix of everything you need from a city break destination.













ne thing you'll notice about Bordeaux is that for a city of its size, claims of being home

to the 'world's largest' are nothing short of plentiful. We'll kick start our 36 hours in the city by putting it out there that this is the world's largest urban World Heritage Site, as recognised by UNESCO. There is plenty to be discovered, and it's best explored with serendipity as your guide. How you choose to do this is up to you; forget planes, trains

and automobiles, in this French city, it's all about trams, bikes and scooters.

A single tram journey will cost you less than a couple of euros, and the twowheeled transport options are available to rent by the minute. Dodging out of the way of locals as they zip along the designated bike lanes is an art form in itself, but as the saying goes: if you can't beat them, join them. You'll be able to flit around the city at great speed, taking in as many of those all-important sights as you can manage before calling it a day and whiling away an hour or two people watching outside a quaint bistro. The Garonne carves its way through the city, so if your sense of direction leaves a lot to be desired, you can always rely on the river to recalibrate your tourist compass.

Your photography prowess will be put to the test at Place de la Bourse, home to the world's largest reflecting pool. If you're fortunate enough to find a split second where youngsters aren't dowsing

Ooh la la!

La Cité du Vin

The Royal Bavarian Wheel is hardly competition for the London Eye, but there's nevertheless something quite endearing about its fairground-esque stature. Enjoy or endure three rotations (depending on how good you are with heights) and, with a stop at the top, you'll have the opportunity to get your bearings and take a photo or two. On a clear day, you will be able to glance out for miles or, failing that, get a bird's eye view of the Place des Quinconces and the majesty of the Monument aux Girondins.

La Cité du Vin in the north of the city is best described as Bordeaux's shrine to all things wine. It's an easy building to spot, a metallic blob that squats conspicuously on the banks of the Garonne. Squint for long enough and you might just be able to make out its carafeshaped silhouette. Inside, there's a host of interactive exhibitions that explore more about wine making all around the world. If the thought of spending these few precious hours

in Bordeaux browsing museum exhibits doesn't exactly fill you with joy, bear with us.

The real treat here lies at the end of your fact-finding foray; head up to the eighth floor to the Belvedere, where your patience will be rewarded. Not only is a tasting included in the price of your ticket, but you'll also be served panoramic views of the city. Le Sobre Chartrons is the indecisive drinkers' dream, so if you've got commitment issues when it comes to choosing a wine, this deceptively demure venue will more than satisfy your curiosity. Served in three, six and 12cl measures siphoned through a futuristic dispenser, this self-service approach to

wine tasting will allow you to experience their très jolie sélection without breaking the bank, or your resolve to take on the rest of the city. A friendly sommelier is on hand to regale you with as many or as few wine facts as you wish.

Every great wine should be paired with an equally as impressive cheese, and the good news is that in Bordeaux, you won't be short of a fromagerie or two. You'd be forgiven for thinking Fromagerie Deruelle is an antiques shop based on its exterior alone, but inside it's all about the cheese. Every variety has

been hand-selected for its quality, and while you could indulge all your foodie fantasies in one go, it pays to be selective. Escadut, a locally-made soft cheese, is well worth a few of your euros.

No visit to France is complete without at least savouring something from a patisserie. In Bordeaux, you won't have

> to commit too much time to tracking down the perfect canelé. These miniscule morsels of sheer indulgence are firmly rooted in the city; it's a petite pastry flavoured with rum and vanilla, with a delicate custard centre. Encased in a thick, caramel crust. it's not something you'll be eating by the dozen, but with plenty of other

food to try, this isn't necessarily a negative. Follow in the footsteps of the locals and find La Toque Cuivree, which has outlets all over Bordeaux.



- > 1 tbsp of extra-virgin olive oil
- > A handful of fresh marjoram
- > A pinch of salt
- > **Ground** black pepper
- > 400g pansotti pasta frozen or fresh

Method

> Put the walnuts, garlic, fresh marjoram and grated parmesan into a small food processor and finely chop.



> Break up the bread into chunks and mix with milk, once combined squeeze the excess milk out. Add the bread to the other ingredients.



- > Add the olive oil, four or five tablespoons of milk, and a generous pinch of salt and pepper.
- > Blend all the ingredients together until well combined to create the walnut sauce.
- > Cook the pasta in heavily salted boiling water until tender, then drain and combine with a little olive oil to avoid sticking. Retain some of the cooking water for the sauce.



- > Combine the walnut sauce with some of the cooking water, add to the pansotti and toss well.
- > Serve hot, garnished with parmesan cheese and chopped walnuts.
