

P&O CRUISES PLANS SIGNIFICANT INVESTMENT IN ARCADIA & AURORA

P&O CRUISES has announced details of a multi-million-pound investment in its two adult-only ships, Arcadia and Aurora.

The initial upgrades are due to be completed imminently, including new balcony furniture and chairs in cabins, as well as improvements to open-deck areas. New lounge chairs, sofas, tables and armchairs will be installed around the Neptune Pool on Arcadia.

"Arcadia and Aurora are two of our most beloved ships in the fleet offering guests a more intimate experience in stylish surroundings. After a busy season hosting guests on longerduration itineraries and world cruises, we will be making sure that both ships look their absolute finest ahead of the summer season," commented P&O Cruises President Paul Ludlow.

A more comprehensive refit is planned on board Arcadia in November 2024, while Aurora's is scheduled to take place in April 2025.





QUEEN ANNE RECEIVES ICONIC CUNARD FUNNEL

QUEEN ANNE has received Cunard's iconic red and black funnel, marking the latest significant milestone in her construction. The distinctive funnel has been a feature of Cunard ships for more than 150 years, during which time it has become synonymous with the cruise line's rich seafaring heritage and reputation for luxury ocean travel.

Construction of the brand-new ship is currently underway at the Fincantieri Shipyard in Italy, ahead of Queen Anne's maiden voyage in May 2024.

Angus Struthers, Senior Vice-President of Cunard, said: "We are thrilled to mark this important milestone in

the construction of Queen Anne. The installation of the funnel is a significant step in the building process



and brings the ship one step closer to joining our fleet.

"For Cunard, the distinctive red and black funnel is an iconic symbol of our heritage and will be one of Queen Anne's most recognisable features."

Queen Anne will become the 249th ship to sail under the Cunard flag, where she will enter service alongside Queen Mary 2, Queen Victoria, and Queen Elizabeth. This will mark the first time since 1999 that Cunard will have four Queens at sea. Her maiden season is set to include a number of destinations across Europe, including the Mediterranean and Norwegian Fjords.

This, together with being the first Captain of Iona, was without a doubt the absolute pinnacle of my career. I was also fortunate enough to be asked to captain Arcadia for a section of her world cruise in 2019, and having the chance to revisit the Southern Hemisphere, most notably Sydney in Australia, is something I shall never forget. That being said, Iona will forever hold a special place in my heart and the excitement and anticipation of standing on the quayside looking up at this stunning ship for the first time will forever be my 'pinch me' moment.

YOU'VE UNDOUBTEDLY SEEN SOME **AMAZING SIGHTS SINCE TAKING THE HELM OF IONA, WHICH ONE(S) STAND OUT FOR YOU?**

It's very hard to pick one! The two that really stand out for me though are firstly our maiden voyage, where I had



the opportunity to take Iona to her namesake island off the western coast of Scotland. This was something truly special - as we made our approaches, we were bathed in glorious sunshine and afforded our guests some stunning

views of the mystical isle. We remained there until late in the evening, where our guests were further treated to the most spectacular firework display accompanied by a piper in full dress and two traditional Scottish dancers. As a proud Scotsman myself, I will gladly admit I shed a very happy tear that night! Secondly, I was delighted

to be onboard when we took lona to her spiritual home of Norway for the first time. Iona was designed to cruise Norway and its breathtaking fjords; the welcome we received from the locals



as we sailed into each port for the first time was out of this world, and it really is such a pleasure to revisit those shores throughout the summer months.

WHAT DOES AN AVERAGE DAY LOOK LIKE FOR YOU AS A CAPTAIN?

I suppose another aspect of my job I love (there really are many!) is that no two days are the same. That being said, on a port day I will always be on the Bridge at least 30 minutes prior to our pilot boarding to undergo a full handover and brief with the team to discuss our manoeuvre. I will then brief the pilot to make sure their plan matches ours, and once I've safely brought the ship alongside, I may then pop down to the gangway to see our guests ashore. I find this is a great way of interacting with many of our guests and hearing about their adventures so far. From there, I will take the time to walk the crew areas to catch up with as many of the team members as possible. As Captain, I am responsible for all the operations we carry out onboard, but I am blessed to work with such a dedicated and professional ship's company. My day could then be filled with various meetings, inspections, drills and, of course, emails. It will then be time to return to the Bridge for our departure. There's certainly plenty to keep me busy.

WHICH VENUES ARE YOUR FAVOURITES ON BOARD IONA? ANY HINTS OR TIPS YOU CAN SHARE WITH OUR READERS?

I absolutely adore our SkyDome and Grand Atrium - both are multipurpose venues, ideal for relaxing during the day and watching the ever-changing scenery pass you by, before coming alive as entertainment venues in the evening. As for our restaurant venues, there are over 17 on board, so you really are spoilt for choice.

Here's a little insider's tip ... why not try your own Iona dining tour? You could begin with some delicious tapas from our Food Hero José Pizarro in The Glass House, then move up to Deck 8 for a sumptuous steak in the Keel & Cow and finish off (if you can manage it!) by having a delicious artisan ice cream at Ripples, our very own onboard gelateria. A real treat for all the 'foodies' out there!

Thankfully, P&O Cruises invests a lot of time and money in developing and honing our skills, for example prior to lona coming into service, the Bridge team and I spent several

days in our simulator facility in the Netherlands. Here, we were able to practice manoeuvring or pirouetting Iona in and out of some of the more challenging ports of call we were due to visit.

IS THERE ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD YOU HAVEN'T YET VISITED, BUT **WOULD LIKE TO?**

Throughout my career, I've been lucky enough to visit most of the areas I had always wanted to, from the Arctic to the Antarctic and lots of places in between. However, I have never had the opportunity to visit Alaska, so that one is definitely on my bucket list!

HAVE YOU HAD THE OPPORTUNITY TO GET ON BOARD ARVIA, AND IF SO, WHAT DO YOU THINK ABOUT HER?

I haven't had the opportunity to get on board Arvia ... yet! I'm quite sure the time will come though, and from what I have seen already from the pictures and heard from my colleagues on board, she looks like yet another beautiful addition to our fleet. I'm particularly looking forward to trying out her

new dining concepts and also giving the Mission Control escape room a try.





DISCOVERING

THE DANUBE

RIVER CRUISING is new territory to me. I've seen ships docked in the heart of cities throughout Europe during my travels, and often wondered how the experience would compare to sailing across the ocean.

APT has 90 years' experience sailing some of the world's most impressive rivers, so when they invited me to join them for a five-day sailing along the Danube, I knew I was in safe hands. The river cruise departed from the Austrian capital of Vienna destined for the Bavarian city of Nuremberg, and I sailed on Travelmarvel Vega, which is part of a brand-new fleet of three identical four-star premium sister ships including the Polaris and Capella. I couldn't wait to see what the next few days had in store.

DAY 1 First Impressions

After stepping off the plane and going through all of the obligatory airport checks, I was pleased to see a comfortable coach transfer waiting outside the arrivals hall. After a short journey - and as if my first impressions couldn't have been any better - a member of the APT team welcomed me with a glass of Champagne as I stepped onto the ship. The checkin process was smooth, and the crew assisted me by carrying my suitcase straight to my stateroom.

With a little time to spare, I was determined to explore one of the most exciting areas of the ship - my cabin! I was assigned a French Balcony stateroom, where the furnishings reminded me of a

boutique hotel. The decor was fresh and modern, and the space featured a seating area, vanity unit, TV, and a spacious wardrobe. The bathroom was just as impressive; the walk-in shower was as big as those I've encountered in hotels on land, and the complimentary toiletries were more luxurious than I could have ever imagined.

Once I'd quickly spruced myself up, it was time to see exactly what an evening on board Travelmarvel Vega had in store. As it turned out, I was treated to the first of many four-course meals of the cruise, which was accompanied by complimentary wine, as is the case with all meals on board. This was followed by a competitive quiz in the lounge, after which I headed to bed - it's fair to say I was impressed by what I'd seen so far!









I'm glad to report the sumptuous double bed lived up to my expectations; I begrudgingly dragged myself out of it and, to really make the most of my first morning on board, reached into the wardrobe and wrapped myself in a big snuggly robe. I pulled back the curtains to take in my first daylight view of the Danube.



At first, I thought I had a picture window from which I could view the passing scenery (of which there was plenty) but soon discovered a button on the wall. Suddenly, the French Balcony element of the room description made sense - as soon as I pressed it, a half-open window ledge was revealed that I was able to peer out of. What a brilliant idea for both warm and cold climates!

It was then I noticed a piece of paper pushed under my door titled 'a Wachau kind of day'; it revealed that after leaving our first port of call,

Dürnstein, we would sail down the most picturesque stretch of the Danube known for its rolling hills, vineyards, fortresses and baroque architecture. Pictures and videos just didn't do this section of the river justice and after seeing it for myself, I can safely say this is something you need to appreciate with your own eyes.

In Dürnstein, we were given free time to explore the quaint Austrian town dotted with souvenir and chocolate shops. A gentle hike to Dürnstein Castle presented captivating views of the town, as well as the Danube in all its glory. Later that evening, we docked in Melk for a guided tour of Melk Abbey, an active Benedictine

monastery since 1089 that sits majestically on a rocky outcrop overlooking the river. Yes, that's right, two ports in one day! In fact, we visited three countries and seven destinations over five days ... pretty impressive when you think about it.

Just when I thought the day couldn't get any better, the APT crew joined us on deck to serve Austria's favourite cocktail 'The Hugo Spritz', alongside a selection of warm pastries. It was the most immersive and enjoyable experience I've had whilst cruising, as it brought us closer to the destinations we were visiting through their food and drink.




Authentic Experiences

After a leisurely breakfast, we disembarked in Brandstatt to join a guided tour of the remarkable UNESCO World Heritage site and Czech town of Český Krumlov, home to a castle dating back to 1240. For somebody who doesn't

> take a lot of interest in history, I can honestly say these excursions completely changed my outlook. Throughout my trip, the APT tour guides were so knowledgeable, but also had a great sense of humour, so both elements combined truly brought each story to life. What stood out to me most was the more unusual facts and

stories about the town, including aspects you would never notice or question when passing by as a tourist exploring independently. We were told that if the exterior of the buildings was peeled back, each one would reveal different styles of painted ornamentation, from Gothic to Renaissance and even Baroque.

Throughout my trip, the APT tour guides were so knowledgeable, but also had a great sense of humour, so both elements combined, truly brought each story to life.



Various renovations have taken place over the years and it was fascinating to learn that so much of the artwork has been preserved beneath the facades.

With free time to explore before setting sail for Linz, I visited Švejk Restaurant, a local eatery that came highly recommended by the tour guide. I ordered the kulajda, a traditional Czech cream soup with mushrooms, potatoes, eggs and fresh dill, which washed down nicely with a stein of Pilsner. It was great to live life like a true local.

That evening in Linz, the ship hosted a Bavarian night. The menu reflected dishes served in the German state, such as spaetzle, a delicious take on mac and cheese. Afterwards in the lounge, we were joined onboard by a local dance group, the Bavarian Devils, who performed traditional folk music and dancing whilst we sampled local beer and weisswurst. A truly memorable day!



DAY 4 Travelmarvel Vega

Alfresco Lounge

My day began at leisure, giving me time to explore Travelmarvel Vega. My initial thoughts were how modern, spacious

and inviting the ship was - there were so many highlights on board that naming just a few is quite a task. The Alfresco Lounge was a really versatile space, transforming throughout the day depending on what activities and events were taking place. You can grab a variety of hot drinks, indulge

in afternoon tea, read a book or play a board game whilst comfortably watching ever-changing vistas through the floor-to-ceiling windows. There is also a casual dining option for guests who want a light lunch. The Alfresco Lounge leads out to the front deck, where you can enjoy the fresh air whilst snuggled under a throw. Once night

falls, it is a real hive of activity, where entertainment varies from jukebox nights to other special events.

The two dining options on board were the main restaurant and McGeary's Bar, the only Irish pub to be found on a river

cruise ship. I loved the concept; it's like stepping into a pub in Dublin, with dimmed down lights, dark green leather and polished wood, except you have exceptional river views from the aft of the ship. Here, you will find typical pub grub including pies and paninis; Guinness is served by the bottle and world football matches are

screened.

From my trip, I discovered that the river cruising experience is more about disembarking the ship rather than staying on board. That said, brandnew ships such as Travelmarvel Vega ensure the experience on board is just as good as off, making for a really memorable holiday.

My initial thoughts were how modern, spacious and inviting the ship was - there were so many highlights on board.



DAY 5 Aye, Aye Captain!

Making the most of my final hours, I joined Captain Rudy on deck as he manoeuvred the ship through a lock. Not only was this amazing to witness, but I had the opportunity to sit in the Captain's chair and have a tutorial on the navigational charts and equipment. Captain Rudy had been sailing on the rivers for over

13 years, so it was great to spend time with him and ask all my burning questions. He was so knowledgeable and approachable that this became a personal highlight of the cruise.

We disembarked the ship around midday, and were invited on a guided tour of Nuremberg to make the most of our time before an evening flight home. This gave me the opportunity to reflect on my five days on the Danube, after which I'm happy to admit I am a

converted river cruiser. As I reminisced on my experience with APT, it was evident that the value for money when booking a Travelmarvel river cruise was really quite incredible - there wasn't an hour that went by where I wasn't receiving a best-in-class travel experience.

I'm already searching for my next adventure ... the question is, which river will I sail?





The thought of Disney on a cruise ship was just mind-blowing, and despite having been on many different cruise lines over the years, the opportunity had never arisen to try this one. After spending a few days at Walt Disney World Resort in Florida, I headed to Port Canaveral, Disney Cruise Line's home port, for what was to be the start of a truly enchanted sailing.








A First Encounter

EMBARKATION DAY is always exciting, but this one had that extra-special sprinkling of Disney magic. As I pulled up at the terminal, I caught a glimpse of the beautiful dark-blue hull and Rapunzel hanging from the back of the ship with her paintbrush in hand. Even the building itself was something quite unique, with a Mickey Mouse theme throughout. From the moment you arrive, it's quite obvious that you're set for an experience filled with magical moments that will last a lifetime.

Stepping on board the ship was unlike any experience I have ever had - I was very overwhelmed by the exuberance of it all. A cast member announces your arrival to your fellow guests, as if you are appearing at one of Cinderella's grand balls. I chose to be introduced slightly unusually, with the cast member exclaiming "please welcome aboard the Disney Wish, Bolsover Cruise Club!" I arrived into the atrium - or as Disnev calls it, the Grand Hall - which is strikingly beautiful, and unlike any other atrium I have ever seen. It is designed to be like the ballroom of a castle and manages to achieve just that without feeling staged.

DISNEY WISH is designed to feel as though you are inside a beautiful and modern Cinderella's castle. On reflection, it was without a doubt the most luxurious family cruise I have ever sailed on; it is very clever how subtle the Disney influence is in some venues, and how completely immersive it is in others, so you can choose just how Disney-filled you want your

holiday to be. There are plenty of adultonly options to choose from, including a sundeck to rival six-star cruise lines, exquisite dining options such as Enchanté by Chef Arnaud Lallement, where guests can indulge in cuisine with a French flair. Sit back and relax in sophisticated bars like Nightingale's where you'll hear the pianist

play the classic melody of 'Sweet Nightingale'. Or, experience pure bliss at the world-class Senses Spa & Salon, a nature-inspired oasis including the Rainforest, an indoor area that contains heated lounges, fountains and more.

All accommodations and suites are styled with an influence from each

of Disney's famous princess fairy tales; the bathrooms are bright and modern with a separate toilet and shower room. The most stunning, in my opinion, is the Aurora Royal Suite with Verandah - Sleeping Beauty would be more than comfortable resting her head there forever.

As you would expect, the kids' club is on a whole new level - it's even

> accessible from a slide that runs straight into the heart of Disney's Oceaneer Club. I spent a lot of time in children's clubs on cruise ships growing up and loved them so much that it was hard for my parents to drag me out, but they were nothing compared to those on

which holds a series of games hosted by Olaf himself. There's even *Belle's Library*, a cosy corner for reading and acting out stories - there may be a guest appearance! Youngsters might want to head to the *Marvel Super Hero Academy* where they will be trained on how to become a superhero. For intergalactic adventures, kids can visit the Star Wars™ Cargo Bay where they feel as though

they are on board a real spaceship.

Out on deck, there are pools ranging in size and depth to suit your children, as well as a giant outdoor movie screen showcasing Disney films throughout the day. There's also a *Toy Story Splash Zone*, and Disney's first attraction at sea, the *AquaMouse*, an immersive storytelling waterslide. The options really are endless.



A Feast for the Senses

THE DINING EXPERIENCES on board Disney Wish were just incredible and really surpassed my expectations. The service was outstanding in each one I tried; some featured theatrical and interactive performances, and the food is certainly of a premium standard. Evening meals work on a rotational system, allowing guests to experience each of the three main dining areas: Worlds of Marvel, 1923 and Arendelle: A Frozen Dining Adventure. In an extraspecial touch, your waiters will follow you around the rotational dining restaurants, ensuring they provide a more personalised service. My waiter knew my name and drink preference by the end of the first evening, and his service was exceptionally attentive.

My personal favourite was 1923; it is a real nod to Disney's history, as it is named after the year Disney was founded. It features a classic American grill and is tastefully decorated with classic animation sketches and original movie props. The contents of these walls must be worth a staggering fortune! Worlds of Marvel is a fun family

dinner, where a string of MARVEL Super Heroes appear on board *Disney Wish* to save the day. Finally, *Arendelle: A Frozen Dining Adventure* is another family fun evening, with Elsa, Olaf, and Oaken hosting a musical engagement party for Anna and Kristoff, with guests invited to join them.

While the three main restaurants are included in the cruise fare, adults can opt to dine in either of the speciality restaurants *Enchanté by Chef Arnaud Lallement* and *Palo Steakhouse* for an additional charge. These restaurants are beautifully designed and are a great option for a more romantic night at sea.

I must give mention to *Star Wars: Hyperspace Lounge,* which is extremely cool, even if you're not particularly familiar with Star Wars™. You're transported to a bar on a travelling spaceship, where a large virtual window depicts scenes of the universe as you travel through space.











Extra-Special Experiences


MY FAVOURITE evening onboard Disney Wish was definitely Pirate Night, a deck party that puts all other deck parties to the test. I have never seen so many people attend and get involved, it was honestly amazing. Most of my fellow cruisers dressed as pirates (with some taking it more seriously than others) and we danced the night away in the middle of the Caribbean. A band performed, and Captain Jack Sparrow joined the party, inevitably setting off a firework display - that's right, a fireworks display on a cruise ship! As if that's not magical enough, the fireworks explode and turn into fish food to feed Nemo and his friends.

During the cruise, we made a stop at Castaway Cay, Disney's private Caribbean escape. This is a gorgeous tiny island with long white sand beaches, shallow clear blue waters and a plethora of activities to choose from. I opted for Serenity Bay, the adults-only beach, where I spent the whole day laying on sunbeds in the really shallow water - it was heaven. There are various cool secrets to discover around the island, and my top fact is that if you go snorkelling around the shoreline, you will find items like King Triton's sword and Maui's Hook. It really is a fun day that you can tailor to suit how you want your holiday, and features on most Disney Cruise Line Caribbean and Bahamian itineraries.

Overall, Disney Wish was more incredible than I ever could have dreamt it would be. 




FRANCE 🏴

For all its glamour, the headline resident of the second-smallest country in the world (Monaco) is as culturally rich as it is exuberant. Try your hand in the world-famous casino or enjoy a splash of the high life ogling multimillion-pound yachts in the stunning harbour - Monte Carlo is downright glitzy and it knows it.

Marseille has also edged its way onto many itineraries of late, a fitting tribute given its roots are firmly planted in maritime history. Vieux Port finds itself as the pulsating heart of the city, where locals and fleeting visitors alike descend no matter whether it's daybreak or nightfall. Regardless of where you find yourself in France's second city, the silhouette of Notre-Dame de la Garde is never far behind. Firmly planted proudly atop a 154-metre-high viewpoint slap-bang in the centre of the action, it affords 360-degree views of what lies below - or simply acts as a compass should you ever find yourself wayward in Marseille.





ITALY 🏴

Next, you're invited to slip your foot into the boot of Italy, a destination that never fails to provide the perfect fit. A trip to Rome comes with the stipulation that vou'll dock at Civitavecchia. We'll level with you - it's not the most attractive port, and the historical centre stands around two hours away. This aside, it's well worth the procession inland, where arguably one of Europe's - if not the world's - greatest cities begs to be explored. Whether you're a ticking those tourist sights off your list type, or would simply rather wander the ancient streets and see what you happen across, there's no finer place to do it than Rome.

Positano provides the antithesis of this gladiator of a city, with no sights of note to clap eyes on. The scenery speaks for itself in an almost whisperlike fashion - a smooth talker if ever we've encountered one. A drive along the Amalfi Coast is all that is necessary to convince you of this fact, where

precariously stacked pastel-coloured villages clamber up the hillsides on one side, as azure waters glisten down below on the other. Lemon trees dangle their wares within touching distance, as picture-perfect piazzas invite you to take your foot off the pedal and while away an hour or two doing absolutely nothing. If this isn't the good life, we don't know what is.

Split, Croatia's second-largest city, is as much a feast for the eyes as it is for the stomach, where the finest Mediterranean fare punctuates every day from morning 'til night. Coffee connoisseurs slowly morph into wine suppers - it is the perfect peephole into how life is really lived in Dalmatia. Dubrovnik may be the Hollywood heartthrob of these parts, but Split is right there in the wings as its leading lady. No visit would be complete without gazing in wonderment at Diocletian's Palace, a sprawling Roman artefact firmly ensconced in a prime harbourside location. But don't be fooled, this is far from a palace in the true sense of the word. As you penetrate the walls, you'll find a labyrinth of streets plotted with as many as 220 buildings that thousands of people call home. Whether you have a penchant for Roman architecture, or just want somewhere to rest your legs and enjoy a glass of Dalmatian wine, Diocletian's Palace invites you to pull up a chair.







MONTENEGRO

Modern-day Montenegro finds itself in the place previously occupied by Croatia - namely as the up-and-coming destination of the Adriatic. Small but perfectly formed, this pocket-sized piece of prime holiday real estate delivers everything in abundance. Sailing through the serene waters of the Bay of Kotor will give you Norwegian Fjord-type vibes, but with the added benefit of a Mediterranean climate. 


GREECE 🎏

Ephesus delights in so many ways. Frequented by the Romans, Byzantines and Ottomans, you are sure to be in esteemed company as the ancient ruins regale visitors with tales of centuries past. The Temple of Hadrian has stood proudly since the first century and is in fine fettle, even if we do say so ourselves. Or, pay a visit to the House of the Virgin Mary, where thousands of people make the pilgrimage every year.

One thing is for sure - historical Turkey is very much the paradox of bartering for touristic wares on the streets of Bodrum, or the unrestrained opulence of Istanbul. But if variety is, indeed, the spice of life, then this corner of the Med is the most potent of them all.





ATHENS' historical mettle comes in the shape of being the oldest capital in Europe. And, let's face it, any city that has been continuously inhabited for 3,400 years must have at least something going for it. The Greek capital is where science, philosophy and even athletics first came into being - the birthplace of every school child's nemeses, if you will. While a mere 36 hours hardly seems long enough to blow centuries of dust off the surface, it is at least a good place to start.

Athens is the stuff history books are made of, and there's little option but for at least some customary sightseeing to creep onto your shortlist. Let's get the most obvious attraction out of the way - and that's

the Parthenon. It has been watching patiently over the city since the 13th century, a shrine to the fact that decent workmanship really can stand the test of time. In short, what it can't tell you about the goings-on down below probably isn't worth knowing.


You've got two choices here - scale the Acropolis in person and get as close as is humanly (and legally) possible, or snap the unmistakable columns from ground level. Luckily for you, the Parthenon is illuminated after night shrouds the city, so is bound to elbow its way onto your camera roll whether you like it or not. If you do decide to get up close and personal, there's a museum to cement your efforts, and you'll be further rewarded with amazing views of the city.

If that hasn't satisfied your insatiable appetite for Ancient Greek history, the Agora will be only too happy to oblige. Located on the north-western slope of the Acropolis, you won't have to wander too far off course to find it. You'll be greeted with a trinity of historical wonderment in the shape of the grand Temple of Hephaistos, a museum, and the Byzantine Church of the Holy Apostles, which dates back to the 11th century. While there's a hefty collection of stubborn ruins to peruse, this is also one of the greener parts of Athens, creating an almost park-like atmosphere that's hard

to track down in other areas of the city.

Should you have the desire to see something a little more 'intact' during your time in Athens, Plateia Syntagmatos will satisfy your curiosity. For all intents and purposes, it's a city square probably not unlike any other you've encountered across Europe. The rose-hued Hellenic Parliament building is where the excitement lies; time your visit just right to see the changing of the guard, which takes place every hour. The duo will break free from their stations in a

perfectly choreographed routine that would put even the National Ballet to shame, kicking their legs higher than you would think is anatomically feasible. Their pom-pom shoes are a sight to behold, and you'll be left wondering just how they survive the heady temperatures of the summer in so much clobber, which includes a rather trendy fez and weighty kilt.


best foot forward in those swanky sandals?



INGREDIENTS:

- > 600g wagyu sirloin steak
- > 20g of teriyaki sauce

GARNISH:

- > **80g** of shallots, finely sliced into rings
- > 20g of teriyaki sauce
- > 200g of wakame (seaweed) salad
- > **5g** of smoked black Kampot pepper (or black peppercorns)
- > 1 box of micro cress

METHOD:

- **1.** Coat the wagyu beef in the teriyaki sauce and marinate in the fridge for at least 12 hours.
- **2.** Slice the shallots into rings and shallow-fry with oil in a hot pan until crispy, and set aside.
- **3.** Sear the sides of the beef using a blowtorch. This authentic cooking method preserves the best qualities of the meat. Alternatively, briefly sear in a hot pan.
- **4.** Slice the beef into 4cm chunks and serve along the centre of a plate.
- **5.** Spoon over the teriyaki sauce and wakame salad. Finish with the crispy shallots, smoked Kampot black pepper and micro cress.
